No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office except as authorized under the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provisions of the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt form federal income tax under Section 501(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) by a corporation, the contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. ·00/

Article 6. Dissolution

In the event of the dissolution or liquidation of the Corporation, the Board of Directors, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, shall distribute, in any proportions considered prudent, all of the assets of the Corporation to (a) to El Rincon Supportive Services Organization, a.k.a. El Rincon Community Clinic, if then in existence and if qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended from time to time, or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Code"); otherwise (b) to any corporation selected by the Board of Direc ors which is formally affiliated with the Corporation (including any successor or survivor corporations) at the time of the dissolution and qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or (c) if no such affiliated corporation exists at the time of the Corporation's dissolution or is not qualified as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, then in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and as the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall determine in accordance with the Illinois General Notfor-Profit Corporation Act of 1986, as amended from time to time, or any other applicable law. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, to such organization or organizations as such court shall determine which are organized and operated for such purposes.
