## The Court finds as follows:

- 1. It has jurisdiction of the parties and the subje x matter;
- 2. All material allegations of the complaint have be in proved and are true;
- 3. Plaintiffs, STANLEY OLSZEWSKI and NANCY CLSZEWSKI, are the owners in fee simple of real estate situated in Cook County, Illinois, and described in the complaint as follows:

Lots 1 and 2 in Block 4 in Alfred Cowles addition to Chicago, being a subdivision of the North ½ of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 31, Township 38 North, Range 15, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

Plaintiffs are in actual possession of said property,

- 4. Defendants, JOHN CARPENTER and MARY CARPENTER, unlawfully claim some interest or right in the premises by virtue of an Installment Agreement for Warranty Deed, recorded in the office of the recorder of deeds of Cook County, Illinois on July 2, 1999 as document number 99640437;
- 5. The defendants' Installment Agreement for Warranty Deed appears valid, but it is actually invalid for reason of Notice of Default served upon Defendants on March 12, 1999 and, further, by reason of Order of Possession entered against Defendants on January 5, 2000. The Installment Agreement for Warranty Deed constitutes a cloud on the title to the real estate, greatly diminishing its value and interfering with its sale; and
  - 6. The equities of this case are with plaintiffs.
