IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

- 1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid, and in case of the failure of the First Party, to: (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens, claims for lien, second mortgages, or the like; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises; (4) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) refrain from making material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance; (7) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges against the premise when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to holders of the Note duplicate receipts therefore; (8) pay in full under protest the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which First Party may desire to contest; (9) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning or windsform under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full the indebtedness secured hereby, all companies satisfactory to the holders of the Note, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the holders of the Note, such rights to be evidenced by the standard mortgage clause to be attached to each policy; and deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to holders of the Note, and in case of insurance about to expire, to deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration; then Trustee or the holders of the Note may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore set forth in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting saind premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorney's fees, whether arising before or after the filing of a suit to foreclose the lien of, and other moneys advanced by Trustee or the holders of the Note to protect the mortgaged premises and the lier he eof, plus reasonable compensation to Trustee for each matter concerning which action authorized may be taken, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at a rate per annum equal to the post-maturity rate set forth in the Note securing this Trust Deed, if any, otherwise the pre-maturity rate set forth therein. Inaction of the Trustee or holders of the Note shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any of the provisions of this puragraph.
- 2. The Trustee or the holders of the Note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any (ax assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title of claim thereof.
- 3. At the option of the holders of the Note and without notice to the First Party, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the Note or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the Note, o. (b) in the event of the failure of First Party to comply with any of the terms and conditions set forth in any paragraph hereof or to perform any act set forth in paragraph 1 hereof and such failure shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three-day period.
- 4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the Note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale, whether arising before or after the filing of such suit all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the Note for attorney's fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens ceruff actes, and similar date and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the Note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable; with interest thereon, at the post-maturity rate set forth in the Note securing this Trust Deed, if any, otherwise the pre-maturity rates set forth therein; when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the Note in connections with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by recently after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.
- 5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings; including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any overplus to First Party, as its rights may appear.
- 6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this Trust Deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application of such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall then be occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit, and in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further time with First Party, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) the indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Trust Deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (2) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

7. Trustee or the holders of the Note stall have the right to inspect the premises it all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

8. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, no shall Trustee be obligated to recor this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts comissions hereunder, expect in case of its own-gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it ma require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

- 9. Trustee shall release this Trust Deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that a indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request cany person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the Note representing that all indebtedness hereb secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor Trustee such successor Trustee may accept as the genuine Note herein described any Noted which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior Trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the Note and which purport to be executed on behalf of First Party; and where the release is requested of the original Trustee and it has never executed a certificate of any instrument identifying same as the Note described herein, it may accept as the genuine Note herein described any Note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the Note and which purports to be executed on behalf First Party.
- 10. Trustee may resign by instruments in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument sha have been recorded or riled. In case of resignation, inability or refusal to act of Trustee, then the Recorder of Deeds of the county in which premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority are herein given Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.
- 11. Upon request from the bolders of the Note, the First Party in addition to the principal interest payment provided for therein shadeposit monthly with the holder of the Note on the dates the aforesaid payments are due, a sum equal to 1/2 of the general real estate taxe levied against the premises and/or the cost of insurance on the premises in an amount not less than the lien hereof, to be applied of account of said taxes and/or said insurance when the same shall become due, using the amount of the last available tax and/or insurance by whatever the case may be said abasis for the respective deposits. No interest shall be paid by the holders of the Note secured hereby, of account of said deposit for taxes and/or insurance. There shall be no obligation upon the holders of the Note to obtain any tax and/or insurance bill, or to pay any tax and/or insurance bill, except upon presentation of the current bill by the First Party, provided that the sum of the deposit then available is sufficient to cover the cost of the same.
- 12. Notwithstanding anything here before stated, First Party hereby waives any and all rights or redemption from sale under order of decree of foreclosure of this Trust Deed on behalf of the First Party, acquiring any interest in or title to said premises subsequent to the date hereof.
- 13. Without the advanced written consent of the holders of the Note, First Party does further covenant and agree that it will not transfe convey or cause to be transferred or conveyed or suffer an involuntary transfer or conveyance of the premises or the beneficial interest in the trust holding title to the premises, including the transfer of possession or the premises pursuant to the sale thereof under articles of agreement for the issuance of a Warranty Deed, or otherwise, son long as the debt secured hereby subsists, and further, in the event of such transfer by the First Party without the advanced written consent of the holders of the Note, the holders of the Note, in their sole discretion, and without notice to the First Party, may declare the whole of the debt secured hereby immediately due and payable and such transfer or conveyance number of the holders of the holders of the Note to such transfer, nor shall it affect the right of the holders of the Note to proceed with such action as the holders of the Note shall deed necessary.
- 14. At the option of the holders of the Note and in their sole discretion without any obligation to do so, the insurance proceeds may be used to repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now of hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or destroyed. Refusal on the part of the holders of the Note to release the insurance proceeds for any such repairs, restoration or rebuilding shall not relieve the First Party of its obligation under paragraph hereof.
