In case of default therein, Mortgagee or the holder of the contract may but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbration, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lieu or other prior lien on title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture, affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of these purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee or the holders of the contract to protect the mortgaged premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice. Inaction of Mortgagee or holders of the contract shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to them on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgagors.

5. The Mortgagee or the holder of the contract hereby secured making any payment hereby authorical relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

- 6. Mortgagors shall pay each item of indebtedness herein mentioned, when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the holder of the contract, and without notice to the Mortgagors, all unpaid indebtedness secured by the Mortgago shall notwithstanding anything in the contract or in this Mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable (a) in the case of default in making payment of any installment on the contract which default shall continue for 30 days, or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.
