THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS PREVIOUSLY REFERRED TO ARE:

1. Until the indebtedness aforesaid shall be fully paid. Borrower, and in the case of the failure of Borrower, its successors or assigns shall: (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become an aged or destroyed: (b) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's lien or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to Holders of the Notes; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (e) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinances; (g) pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and pay special taxes special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and upon written request, to furnish to Trustee or to Holders of the Notes duplicate receipts therefore; (h) pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Borrower may desire to contest; (i) keep all buildings and improvements now or hereafter situated on said premises insured against loss or damage by fire, lightening or windstorm (and flood damage, where the lender is required by law to have its loan so insured) under policies providing for payment by the insurance companies of moneys sufficient either to pay the cost of replacing or repairing the same or to pay in full one indebtedness secured hereby, all in companies satisfactory to the Holders of the Notes, under insurance policies payable, in case of loss or damage, to Trustee for the benefit of the Holders of the Notes, such rights to be evidenced by the standard morninge clause to be attached to each policy; and to deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Holders of the Notes, and in case of insurance about to expire, to deliver renewal policies not less than ten days prior to the respective dates of expiration.

NOTICE: Unless Borrower ("you") provide Holders of the New and/or Trustee (collectively "us" or "we") with evidence of the insurance coverage required by your agreement with its, we may purchase insurance at your expense to protect our interests in your collateral. This insurance may, but need not, protect your interests. The coverage that we purchase may not pay any claim that you make or any claim that is made against you in connection with the collateral. You may later cancel any insurance purchased by us, but only after providing us with evidence that you have obtained insurance as required by our agreement. If we purchase insurance for the collateral, you will be responsible for the costs of that insurance, including interest and any other charges we may impose in connection with the placement of the insurance, until the effective date of the cancellation of expiration of the insurance. The costs of the insurance may be added to your total outstanding balance or obligation. The costs of the insurance may be more than the cost of insurance you may be able to obtain on your own. If Trustee grany Holder of the Notes purchases insurance on said premises as authorized herein, it will have the right to select the agent. Trustee or the

2. The Trustee or the Holders of the Notes hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without injury into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

3. At the option of the Holders of the Notes hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale forfeiture, tax

lien or title or claim thereof.

4. Borrower agrees not to sell or transfer any part of the premises, or any rights in the premises, including the sale or transfer of the beneficial ownership in the premises where Borrower is a Land Trust, without the written consent of the Holder of the Notes. This includes sale by contract for deed or installment sale. If all or any part of the premises or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Borrower is not a natural person) without Holder of the Note's prior written consent, Holder of the Note may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Trust Deed. However, this option shall not be exercised by Holder of the Note if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Trust Deed.

5. Borrower agrees not to mortgage or encumber by deed of trust all or any part of the premises or allow anyone else to

have a lien on the premises without the written consent of the Holders of the Notes.

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6. Borrower shall pay each nem of indeptedness herein mentioned when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Holders of the Notes, or any of them, and without notice to Borrower, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the Installment Notes or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any of the principal or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the payment of any interest or in the performance of any other agreement or promises of the Borrower herein contained. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Holders of the Notes or Trustee, or any of them shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. Borrower gives Trustee Holders of the Notes or Trustee, or any of them shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. Borrower gives Trustee and/or Holders of the Notes power to sell the premises at a public auction. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses, which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee of Holders of the Notes, or any of them, for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees, may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or Holders of the Notes, or any of them, may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. The proceeds of any force sure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and spenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof, second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the reincipal notes with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the principal notes; fourth, any overplus to Borrower, its successors, legal representatives or assigns,

8. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this Trust Deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such a pointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of the Borrewer at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Borrower, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be received or are usual in such cases for the recreation profession control representation of the recreation of the recr necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, poss(ss)on, control, management, and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. 11. In case of default herein, then Trustee or the Holders of the Notes may, but need not, nake any payment or perform any act hereinbefore set forth in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment.
