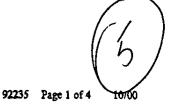

3. At the option of the Holders of the Notes hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale forfeiture, tax

lien or title or claim thereof.

4. Borrower agrees not to sell or transfer any part of the premises, or any rights in the premises, including the sale or transfer of the beneficial ownership in the premises where Borrower is a Land Trust, without the written consent of the Holder of the Notes. have a lien on the premises without the written consent of the Holders of the Notes.

6. Borrower shall pay each item of in letterness herein mentioned when due according to the terms hereof. At the option of the Holders of the Notes, or any of them, and without notice to Borrower, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Trust Deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the Installment Notes or in this Trust Deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any of the principal or (b) when default shall occur and continue for three days in the payment of any interest or in the performance of any other agreement or promises of the Borrower herein contained. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, Holders of the Notes or Trustee, or any of them shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof. Borrower gives Trustee and/or Holders of the Notes power to sell the premises at a public auction. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses, which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee of Holders of the Notes, or any of them, for attorneys' fees, Trustee's fees. appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or Holders of the Notes, or any of them, may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. 7. The proceeds of any foreclosure sole of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the principal notes with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the principal notes; fourth, any overplus to Borrower, its successors, legal representatives or assigns,

as their rights may appear.

- 8. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this Trust Deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of the Borrower at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have the power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sile and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Borrower, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, as see and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management, and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Court from time to time may authorized the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (a) The indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Trust Deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (b) the deficiency in case of sale and deficiency.
- 9. Trustee or Holders of the Notes, or of any of them, shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premise, or to inquire into the validity of the signatures or the identity capacity, or authority of the signatories on the Installment Note or the Trust Deed, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this Trust Deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, not be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.
- 11. In case of default therein then Trustee or the Holders of the Notes may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act hereinbefore set forth in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment.
