CLAIM

FOR LIEN

1. The claimant, Alexander Lumber Company, whose address is P.O. Box 531, Aurora, Illinois, 60507 hereby files notice and claim for lien against Resource Const. & Dev, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "contractor"), Architechnics Pro Corp, (hereinafter referred to as "owners"), and Cole Taylor Bank, and Diamond Screen Process Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "mortgagee") and any and all persons claiming to be interested in the real estate herein.

2. On February 15, 1999, and all other relevant times, owners owned the following described real estate:

3. Owner hired contractor for the construction of the residence on said real estate. Owner obtained their financing from mortgage for the construction of said residence.

4. On or about February 15, 1999, contractor made an oral sub-contract with the claimant for claimant to furnish lumber and other material for and in said residence. On October 8, 1999, claimant completed delivery of all lumber and otherwise fully completed its work under said contract, to the value of \$47,887.00.

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5. There is now due, unpaid and owing to the claimant after allowing all credits, the sum of \$47,877.00, for which with interest claimant claims a lien on said real estate and on the monies or other consideration to become due from the contractor under said contract against said contractor, owner, and mortgagee.
