- On a date unknown to Lien Claimant, Owner, Tenant or one knowingly permitted by 2. the Owner to do so entered into a contract with Contractor wherein Contractor was to provide labor, materials and equipment for the construction of a theater and cultural center, alterations and improvements to and for the benefit of the premises.
- By written contract dated January 10, 2000, Contractor made a subcontract with Lien Claimant to furnish and supply aluminum entrances and storefront, stainless clad doors and frames, hardware, Peerless aluminum windows, louvers in windows, glazing, curtain wall, horizontal steel beams at the main curtain wall and caulking labor, materials, fixtures and equipment to the premises in the amount of \$440,000.00 for said improvement.
- At the special instance and request of Contractor, lien claimant furnished extra and additional materials to and extra and additional labor for said premises in the amount of \$8,187.00.

- perform based upon the completion of predecessor work.
- Contractor is entitled to credits on account as a result of payments in the amount of \$343,968.30 and credit as a result of work not yet performed in the amount of \$39,780.00, leaving due, unpaid and owing to Lien Claimant, after allowing all credits, the sum of \$64,438.70 for which, with interest, Lien Claimant claims a lien on the premises and improvements and to monies or other considerations due or to become due from Owner under said contract between Contractor and Owner.
