Court The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois FPA") has reviewed the High Priority Corrective Action Report submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information is dated August 11, 2000; was received by the Illinois EPA August 28, 2500 and was prepared by Handex of Illinois, Inc. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act ("Act") and 35 Illinois Administrative Code ("35 IAC").

The High Priority Corrective Action Completion Report and associated Professional Engineer Certification indicate corrective action for the above-referenced site was conducted in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan approved by the Illinois EPA. The Corrective Action Completion Report demonstrates that the requirements of Section 57.7(c)(1)(E) of the Act and 35 IAC Section 732.409(a)(2) have been satisfied.

Based upon the certification by Richard Coan, a Registered Professional Engineer of Illinois, and the certification by Equilon Enterprises, L.L.C., the owner and operator of the underground storage tank(s), and pursuant to Section 57.10 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/57.10), your request for a no further remediation determination is granted under the conditions and terms specified in this letter.

Issuance of this No Further Remediation Letter ("Letter"), based on the certification of the Registered Professional Engineer, signifies that: (1) all statutory and regulatory corrective action requirements applicable to the occurrence have been complied with; (2) all corrective action concerning the occurrence has been completed; and (3) no further remediation concerning the

occurrence is necessary for the protection of human health, safety and the environment. Pursuant to Section 57.10(d) of the Act, this Letter shall apply in favor of the following persons:

- 1. Equilon Enterprises, L.L.C.;
- 2. The owner and operator of the UST(s);
- 3. Any parent corporation or subsidiary of the owner or operator of the UST(s);
- 4. Any co-oweer or co-operator, either by joint-tenancy, right of survivorship, or any other party sharing we gal relationship with the owner or operator to whom the letter is issued;
- 5. Any holder of a beneficial interest of a land trust or inter vivos trust, whether revocable or irrevocable;
- 6. Any mortgagee or trustee of a deed of trust of the owner of the site or any assignee, transferee, or any successor-in-morest of the owner of the site;
- 7. Any successor-in-interest of such owner or operator;
- Any transferee of such owner or operator whether the transfer was by sale, bankruptcy proceeding, partition, dissolution of marriage, settlement or adjudication of any civil action, charitable gift, or bequest; or
- 9. Any heir or devisee of such owner or operator.

This Letter, and all attachments, including but not limited to the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice, must be filed within 45 days of its receipt and single instrument with the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in the County where the above-referenced site is located. In addition, the Town of Cicero Groundwater Ordinance #140-97 must of filed as an attachment of this letter with the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles of the applicable county. This Letter shall not be effective until officially recorded by the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles of the applicable County in accordance with Illinois law so it forms a permanent part of the chain of title for the above-referenced property. Within 30 days of this Letter being recorded, a certified copy of this Letter, as recorded, shall be obtained and submitted to the Illinois EPA. For recording purposes, it is recommended that the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter be the first page of the instrument filed.

#### CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF APPROVAL

#### LEVEL OF REMEDIATION AND LAND USE LIMITATIONS

- 1. The remediation objectives for the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter, were established in accordance with the requirements of the Tiered Approach to Corrective Action Objectives (35 LC Part 742) rules.
- 2. As a result of the release from the underground storage tank(s) associated with the above-referenced incident, the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the attached Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter, shall not be used in a manner inconsistent with the following land use limitation: There are no land use limitations.
- 3. The land use limitation specified in this Letter may be revised if:
  - a) Further investigation or remedia, action has been conducted that documents the attainment of objectives appropriate for the new land use; and
  - b) A new Letter is obtained and recorded in accordance with Title XVII of the Act and regulations adopted thereunder.

#### PREVENTIVE, ENGINEERING, AND INSTITUTIONAL CONTROLS

4. Preventive: None.

Engineering: None.

Institutional: This Letter shall be recorded as a permanent part of the chair of title for the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the attached Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this letter.

The Town of Cicero Groundwater Ordinance #140-97 effectively prohibits the installation of potable water supply wells (and the use of such wells) and is an acceptable institutional control under the following conditions:

Each affected or potentially affected (as shown through contaminant modeling) property owner and the City of Cicero must receive written notification from the owner/operator desiring to use the ordinance as an institutional control that groundwater remediation objectives have been approved by the Illinois EPA. Written proof of this notification shall be

submitted to the Illinois EPA within 45 days from the date of this Letter. The notification shall include:

- a) The name and address of the local unit of government;
- b) The citation of the ordinance used as an institutional control in this Letter.
- c) A description of the property being sent notice by adequate legal description or by reference to a plat showing the boundaries;
- A statement that the ordinance restricting the groundwater use has been used by the Illinois EPA in reviewing a request for groundwater remediation objectives;
- e) A statement as to the nature of the release and response action with the name, address, and Illinois EPA inventory identification number; 2.12
- f) A statement as we where more information may be obtained regarding the ordinance.

The following activities shall be grounds for voidance of the ordinance as an institutional control and this Letter:

- a) Modification of the reference ordinance to allow potable uses of groundwater;
- b) Approval of a site-specific request, such as a var ance, to allow use of groundwater at the site;
- c) Violation of the terms of an institutional control recorder.

As a part of its corrective action, the LUST site has relied upon the Town of Cicero Groundwater Ordinance #140-97, prohibiting potable uses of groundwater as defined therein. Proof of notification of affected parties, if any, shall be submitted in accordance with 35 IAC 742.1015(b) and (c) within 45 days of the issuance of this NFR Letter.

5. Failure to establish, operate, and maintain controls in full compliance with the Act, applicable regulations, and the approved corrective action plan may result in voidance of this Letter.

#### **OTHER TERMS**

- 6. Any contaminated soil or groundwater removed, or excavated from, or disturbed at the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter, must be handled in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations.
- 7. Further information regarding the above-referenced site can be obtained through a written request under the Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140) to:

- 8. Pursuant to Section 57.10(e) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/57.10(e)), should the Illinois EPA seek to void this Letter, the Illinois EPA shall provide notice to the owner or operator of the leaking underground storage tank(s) associated with the above referenced incident and the current title holder of the real estate on which the tanks were located, at their last known addresses. The notice shall specify the cause for the voidance, explain the provisions for appeal, and describe the facts in support of the voidance. Specific acts or omissions that may result in the voidance of this Letter include, but shall not be limited to:
  - a) Any violation of institutional controls or industrial/commercial land use restrictions;
  - b) The failure to operate and maintain preventive or engineering controls or to comply with any applicable groundwater monitoring plan;
  - c) The disturbance or removal of contamination that has been left in-place in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan or Completion Report;
  - d) The failure to comply with the recording requirements for the Letter;
  - e) Obtaining the Letter by fraud or misrepresentation; or
  - f) Subsequent discovery of contaminants, not identified as part of the investigative or remedial activities upon which the issuance of the Letter was based, that pose a threat to human health or the environment.

Within 35 days after the date of mailing of this final decision, the owner or operator may petition for a hearing before the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") to contest the decision of the

Illinois EPA. (For information regarding the filing of an appeal, please contact the Board at 312/814-3620.) However, the 35-day period for petitioning for a hearing may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice provided to the Board from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the 35-day initial appeal period. (For information regarding the filing of an extension, please contact the Illinois EPA's Division of Legal Counsel at 217/782-5544.)

# AN AMENDED ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF GROUND WATER AS A POTABLE WATER SUPPLY BY THE INSTALLATION OR USE OF POTABLE WATER SUPPLY WELLS OR BY ANY OTHER METHOD

WHEREAS, certain properties in the Town of Cicero, Illinois, have been used over a period of time for commercial/industrial purposes; and  $^{\circ}$ 

WHEREAS, because of said use, concentration of certain chemical constituents in the groundwater beneath the Town may exceed Class I groundwater quality standards for potable resource ground water as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 620 or Tier 1 residential remediation objectives as set forth in 35 Illinois Administrative Code 742; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cicero desires to limit potential threats to human health from groundwater contamination while facilitating the redevelopment and productivity of properties that are the source of said chemical constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF CICERC, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Use of groundwater as a potable water supply prohibited.

Except as otherwise provided in this Code of Ordinances, the use or attempt to use as a potable water supply groundwater from within the corporate limits of the Town of Cicero by the installation or drilling of wells or by any other method is hereby prohibited. This provision shall not apply to use of groundwater by the Town of Cicero.

Section Two. Penalties.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation.

Section Three. Definitions.

"Person is any individual, partnership, co-partnership, firm, company, limited liability company, corporation, association, joint stock company, trust, estate, political subdivision, or any other legal entity, or their legal representatives, agents, or assigns.

"Potable water" is any water used for human or domestic consumption, including, but not limited to, water used for drinking.

This ordinance is applicable everywhere within the corporate limits of the Town of Cicero.

Section Four. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
