- Owner contracted with Claimant for certain improvements, and Owner authorized or knowingly permitted certain other improvements, to said premises, which included plumbing, carpentry, masonry, landscaping, hardwood, ceramic, and carpet installation, painting, HVAC, insulation, clean up and debris removal, electrical, bathtub refinishing, bath & kitchen fixtures, glass block installation, and general contracting work.
- Claimant completed his work on the premises on December 15, 2000, for which the amount of Six Thousand Eighty Four and 51 Hundredths Dollars (\$6,084.51) remains unpaid. Completed concurrently and at the special instance and request of Owner, Claimant furnished extra and additional labor and materials of the value of Four Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars (\$4,359.00). Out of this amount of extras remaining unpaid, Claimant has agreed to give the sum of Two Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Five Dollars (\$2,795.00) as credit for imperfections in the drywall/painting, tile, plumbing, master bath shower, 10% holdback and kitchen cabirety.
