



**ILLINOIS STATUTORY
SHORT FORM OF
POWER OF ATTORNEY
FOR PROPERTY**

POWER OF ATTORNEY made this 6th day of June, 2001.

1. **Appointment of Agent.** I, **Joan P. Ducayet, 840 Michigan, Unit 11, Evanston, Illinois,** hereby appoint **James W. Ducayet, 840 Michigan, Unit 11, Evanston, Illinois,** as my attorney in fact (my "Agent") to act for me and in my name (in any way I could act in person) with respect to the following powers as defined in Section 3-4 of the "Statutory Short Form Power of Attorney for Property Law" (including all amendments), but subject to any limitations on or additions to the specified powers inserted in paragraph 2 or 3 below.

- (a) Real estate transactions.
- (b) Financial institution transactions.
- (c) Tangible personal property transactions.
- (d) Borrowing transactions.
- (e) All other property powers and transactions.

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2. **Limitations on Powers.** The powers granted above shall not include the following powers or shall be modified or limited in the following particulars:

THESE POWERS WILL CONTINUE TO EXIST IN THE EVENT I BECOME DISABLED OR INCOMPETENT. AGENT IS AUTHORIZED TO EXERCISE THE POWERS LISTED IN PARAGRAPH 1 HEREOF ONLY IN CONNECTION WITH THE REAL ESTATE COMMONLY KNOWN AS 2226 NOYES, EVANSTON, ILLINOIS.

3. **Agent's Power to Delegate.** My Agent shall have the right by written instrument to delegate any or all of the foregoing powers involving discretionary decision making to any person or persons whom my agent may select, but such delegation may be amended or revoked by any agent (including any successor) named by me who is acting under this power of attorney at the time of reference.

4. **Effective Date.** This power of attorney shall become effective on: June 6, 2001.

5. **Termination Date.** This power of attorney shall terminate on: July 15, 2001.
