

3. Notice was published in the Chicago Sun-Times in Chicago, Illinois, from JUNE 3, 2001 through JUNE 5, 2001.



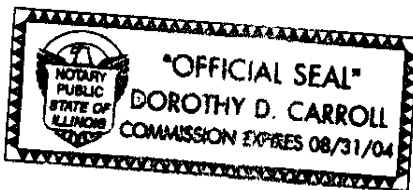


