ORDER OF PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND OF JUDGMENT AND ENFORCEMENT

THIS CAUSE COMING to be heard on the set call, the Court being fully advised in the premises and having heard evidence and testimony that the following items in the City's complaint are not complied to date, it is hereby ordered that:

1. The judgment entered on the date of 10/12/01 in the amount of \$ 18,000 plus \$60 court costs for a total of \$ 18,060 against defendants Jo Ann Kelly shall stand as final judgment and that leave for enforcement of said judgment is granted plaintiff, City of Chicago, instanter.

2. Defendant(s) Jo Ann Kelly and his/her/their agents, heirs, successors or assigns ~~shall~~ from renting, using, leasing, and occupying the entire premises until full compliance with the Municipal Code and further order of court

2.1 Order of full compliance entered 10/12/01 is rescinded
3. ~~Defendant shall schedule and permit interior inspections of the subject premises to verify compliance with the terms of this order. Defendant shall call the inspector at 744- or send written request to the Department of Buildings within 7 days after each compliance date stated in this order.~~

3. Mandatory order v. Equicredit to board & secure all accesses without delay, as well maintain until further order of court
4. The court reserves jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of modification, enforcement or termination of this permanent injunction, including the adjudication of contempt proceedings if the permanent injunction is violated which could result in the imposition of a fine and/or incarceration.

5. This order is final, appealable and enforceable, the court finding no just cause or reason to delay ~~Appeal Judge ABISH C. CUNNINGHAM~~

6. City's petition for rule to show cause v. Equicredit is withdrawn
