Section 3-4 of the Illinois Statutory Short Form Power of Attorney for Property Law

Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of arts mey for property. This Section defines each caregory of powers listed in the statutory short form power of arts mey for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the hite of any of the following categories is retained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers at discretions with respect to the types of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the form of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of purporty or transaction covered by the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or control up, as a joint tenant or tenant in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (a) to make gift, of the principal's property, to exercise powers to appoint to athers or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to take the principal's interests of death as the artificial tenancy, beneficiary form or controctual arrangement. The agent will be under no duty to exercise granted powers or to assume control of or responsibility for the principal's property at affairs; but when controctual arrangement. The agent will be required to use due care to act for the benefit of the principal in occardance will the terms of the statutory property power and will be liable for negligent exercise. The agent may act in person or through others reasonably necessary to implement the exercise of the powers granted to the agent and deliver all instruments, negativate and enter into all agreements and do all other acts reasonably necessary to implement the exercise of the p

- (a) Real estate transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy, soil, exchange, rent and lease real estate (which term includes, without limitation, real estate subject to a land trust and all beneficial interests in and powers of direction under any land trust); collect all rent, sale proceeds and earnings from real estate; convey, assign and accept title to real estate, grant casements, create conditions and release rights of homestedd with respect to real estate; create land trusts and exercise all powers under land trusts; hold, passess, maintain, report, improve, subdivide, manage, operate and insure real estate; pay, contest, protest and compromise real estate raxes and assessments; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to real estate which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust companies, sawings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brakerage firms); deposit in and writhdraw from and write checks on anytinonocal institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could of present and under no disability.
- (c) Stack and band transactions. The agent a authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, writhout limitation, stocks, bands, mutual funds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership poid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all varing rights with respect to securities in person or by groxy, enter into varing trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vale; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

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" (a) I argume personal property transactions, the agent is authorized to; buy and self, lease, exchange, callect, posters and take title to all langible personal property; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to langible personal property; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to langible personal property which the principal could if present and under no disability.

- (e) Safe deposit box transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, continue and have access to all safe deposit boxes; sign, renew, release or terminate any safe deposit contract; drill or surrencer any safe deposit box; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to safe deposit matters which the grincipal could if present and under no disability.
- (f) Insurance and annuity transactions. The agent is authorized to: procure, acquire, continue, renew, terminate or otherwise deal with any type of insurance or annuity contract (which terms include, without limitation, life, occident, health, disability, automobile casualty, property or liability insurance); pay premiums or assessments on or surrender and collect all distributions, proceeds or benefits payable under any insurance or annuity contract; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to insurance and annuity contracts which the proceipal could if present and under no disability.
- (g) Retirement plan transactions. The agent is authorized to: contribute to, withdraw from and deposit funds in any type of retirement plan (which term includes, without limitation, any tax qualified or nonqualified pension, profit sharing, stock bonus, employee savings and other retirement plan, individual retirement account, deferred compensation plan and by other type of employee benefit plan); select and change payment apriors for the principal under any retirement plan; make railover contributions from any retirement plans. It after the principal under any type of self-directed retirement plans and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to retirement plans and retirement plan account balances which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (h) Social Security, use mpl syment and military service benefits. The agent is authorized to: prepare, sign and file any claim or application for Social Security, unemployment or military service be left; sue for, settle or abandon any claims to any benefit or assistance under any federal, state, local or foreign statute or regulation; control, deposit to any account, collect, local, for, and take title to and hold all benefits under any Social Security, unemployment, military service or other state, federal, local or foreign statute or regulation; and, in personal, exercise all powers with respect to Social Security, unemployment, military service and governmental benefits which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (i) Claims and Illigation. The agent is authorized to: institute, presente, dufend, abandon, compromise, arbitrate, settle and dispase of any claim in lavor of aragainst the principal or any property interests of the principal; callect and receipt for any laim or settlement proceeds and waive or release all rights of the principal; employ attaineys and others and enter into contingency agreements and other contracts as necessary in connection with litigation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to claims and litigation which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (k) Commodity and option transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy, sell, exchange assign, convey, settle and exercise commodities futures contracts and call and put options on stocks and stock indices traded on a regulated options exchange and collect and in cipit or all proceeds of any such transactions; establish or continue option accounts for the principal with any securities or futures broker; and, in general, exercise all power, with espect to commodities and options which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- Business operations. The agent is authorized to: organize or continue and conduct any business (which term in uces, without limitation, any farming, manufacturing, service, mining, retailing or other type of business operation) in any form, whether as a proprietorship, joint venture, port in this, corporation, trust or other legal entity; operate, buy, sell, expand, controot, terminate or liquidate any business; direct, control, supervise, manage or participate in the quenture. If any business and engage, compensate and discharge business managers, employees, agents, attarneys, accountants and consultants; and, in general, exercise of powers with respect to business interests and operations which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (m) Borrowing transactions. The agent is authorized to: borrow money; martgage or pledge any real estate or langible or intangil le personal property as security for such purposes; sign, renew, extend, pay and satisfy any notes or other forms of abligation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to secured and unsecured borrowing which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (n) Estate transactions. The agent is authorized to: accept, receipt for, exercise, release, reject, renounce, assign, disclaim, demand, sue for, claim and recover any legacy, bequest, devise, gift or other property interest or payment due or payable to or for the principal; assert any interest in and exercise any power over any trust, estate or property subject to fiduciary control, establish a revocable trust solely for the benefit of the principal that terminates at the death of the principal and is then distributable to the legal representative of the estate of the principal; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to estates and trusts which the principal could if present and under no disability; provided, however, that the agent may not make or change a will and may not revoke or amend a trust revocable or amendable by the principal or require the trustee of any trust for the benefit of the principal to pay income or principal to the agent unless specific authority to that end is given, and specific reference to the trust is made, in the statutory property power form,
- (a) All other property powers and transactions. The agent is authorized to: exercise all possible powers of the principal with respect to all possible types of property and interests in property, except to the extent the principal limits the generality of this category (a) by striking out one or more of categories (a) through (n) or by specifying other limitations in the statutary property power form.

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
