The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the Corrective Action Completion Report submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information is dated January 22, 2002; was received by the Illinois EPA January 24, 2002; and was prepared by Alpha Environmental, Inc. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 IAC).
