The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Thinois EPA) has reviewed the December 13, 2001 Corrective Action Completion Report and supplementary correspondence submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information was prepared by Adept Environmental Solutions. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 IAC).

The Corrective Action Completion Report and the Professional Engineer Certification submitted pursuant to 35 IAC Section 732.300(b) and Section 732.409(b) in ticate the remediation objectives set forth in 35 IAC Section 732.408 have been met.

Based upon the certification by David G. Yacko, a Registered Professional Fagineer of Illinois (062-037001), and pursuant to Section 57.10 of the Act (415 ILCS 5/57.10), your request for a no further remediation determination is granted under the conditions and terms specified in this letter.

Issuance of this No Further Remediation Letter (Letter), based on the certification of the Registered Professional Engineer, signifies that: (1) all statutory and regulatory corrective action requirements applicable to the occurrence have been complied with; (2) all corrective action concerning the occurrence has been completed; and (3) no further remediation concerning the occurrence is necessary for the protection of human health, safety and the environment. Pursuant to Section 57.10(d) of the Act, this Letter shall apply in favor of the following persons:

- 1. Kera Lite Oil;
- 2. The owner and operator of the underground storage tank systems;
- Any parent corporation or subsidiary of the owner or operator of the underground storage tank systems;
- 4. Any co-owner or co-operator, either by joint-tenancy, right of survivorship, or any other party sharing a legal relationship with the owner or operator to whom the letter is issued;
- 5. Any holder of a beneficial interest of a land trust or inter vivos trust, whether revocable or irrevocable;
- 6. Any mortgagee of trustee of a deed of trust of the owner of the site or any assignee, transferee, or any successor-in-interest of the owner of the site;
- 7. Any successor-in-interest of such owner or operator;

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- 8. Any transferee of such owner or operator whether the transfer was by sale, bankruptcy proceeding, partition, dissolution of marriage, settlement or adjudication of any civil action, charitable gift, or bequest; or
- 9. Any heir or devisee of such owner or operator.

This Letter, and all attachments, including but not limited to the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice, must be filed within 45 days of its receipt as a single instrument with the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in the County where the above-referenced site is located. This Letter shall not be effective until officially recorded by the Office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles of the applicable County in accordance with Illinois law so it forms a permanent part of the chain of title for the above-referenced property. Within 30 days of this Letter being recorded, a certified copy of this Letter, as recorded, shall be obtained and submitted to the Illinois EPA. For recording purposes, it is recommended that the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter be the first page of the instrument filed.

CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF APPROVAL

LEVEL OF REMEDIATION AND LAND USE LIMITATIONS

1. The remediation objectives for the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter, were established in accordance with the requirements of the Tiered Approach to Corrective Action Objectives (35 IAC Part 742) rules.

As a result of the release from the underground storage tank systems associated with the above-referenced incident, the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the attached Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter, shall not be used in a manner inconsistent with the following land use limitation: There are no land use limitations.
- 3. The land use limitation specified in this Letter may be revised if:
 - a. Further investigation or remedial action has been conducted that documents the attainment of objectives appropriate for the new land use; and
 - b. A new Letter is obtained and recorded in accordance with Title XVII of the Act and regulations adopted thereunder.

PREVENTIVE, ENGINFERING, AND INSTITUTIONAL CONTROLS

Institutional: This Letter shall be recorded as a permanent part of the chain of title for

Any contaminated soil or groundwater removed, or excavated from or disturbed at the above-referenced site, more particularly described in the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Environmental Notice of this Letter, must be handled in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations under 35 IAC Subtitle G.

Pursuant to Section 57.10(e) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/57.10(e)) and 35 IAC Section 732.704, should the Illinois EPA seek to void this Letter, the Illinois EPA shall provide notice to the owner or operator of the leaking underground storage tank systems associated with the above-referenced incident and the current title holder of the real estate on which the underground storage tank systems were located, at their last known addresses. The notice shall specify the cause for the voidance, explain the provisions for appeal, and describe the facts in support of the voidance. Specific acts or omissions that may result in the voidance of this Letter include, but shall not be limited to:
 - a. Any violation of institutional controls or industrial/commercial land use restrictions;
 - b. The failure to operate and maintain preventive or engineering controls or to comply with any applicable groundwater monitoring plan;
 - c. The disturbance or removal of contamination that has been left in-place in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan or Completion Report;
 - d. The failure to comply with the recording requirements for the Letter;
 - e. Obtaining the Letter by fraud or misrepresentation; or

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- f. Subsequent discovery of contaminants, not identified as part of the investigative or remedial activities upon which the issuance of the Letter was based, that pose a threat to human health or the environment
- 9. a. Leaking Underground Storage Tank Incident 20 11 855 applies to the reported release from the following underground storage tank systems:
 - i. 1-2,000 gallon diesel fuel underground storage ta ik system.
 - b. The indicator contaminants for Leaking Underground Storage Tan't Incident 20011855 were as follows: BETX and PNAs.

An underground storage tank system owner/operator may appeal this decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Appeal rights are explained in Attachment 2.









AREA TOPOGRAPHY MAP








FIGURE 3 SITE PLAN KERA LITE OIL 2945 South Harlem Avenue Berwyn, Illinois LUST Incident # 2001-1855 Adept Environmental Solutions, Inc. La Grange, Illinois



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




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

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ATTACHMENT 2

APPEAL RIGHTS

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An underground storage tank system owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(4)(D) and Section 40 of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by writer notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a startment of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sera to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
