- 1. FOR VALUE RECEIVED, the undersigned ST. PHILIP EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH CF CHICAGO, ILLINOIS, MISSOURI SYNOD A/K/A ST. PHILIP'S EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH OF CHICAGO A/K/A ST. PHILIP EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH (the "Bo rower"), a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, promises to pay to the order of LUTHERAN CHURCH EXTENSION FUND-MISSOURI SYNOD (the "Lender"), a Missouri not-for-profit corporation, the principal sum of Three Hundred Sixty Six Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Nine and 00/100 Dollars (\$366,469.00), or so much thereof as has been disbursed by Lender pursuant to the Construction Loan and Disbursement Agreement (as defined in 14.3), together with interest thereon, as follows:
 - 1.1 <u>Interest</u>. The rates of interest payable by Borrower to Lender hereunder are as follows:
 - 1.1.1 <u>Construction Interest Rate</u>. From and including the date hereof until the Closing Date (as defined in 14.2), interest shall accrue and be payable on the principal balance from time to time outstanding at the rate of Five and Three Eighths percent (5.375%) per annum.
 - 1.1.2 <u>Permanent Initial Interest Rate</u>. From and including the Closing Date until the first Change Date (as defined in 14.1), interest shall accrue and be payable on the principal balance from time to time outstanding at the rate of Four and Three Eighths percent (4.375%) per annum.
 - 1.1.3 <u>Variable Interest Rate</u>. From and including each Change Date, interest shall accrue and be payable on the principal balance from time to time outstanding at the Variable Interest Rate established in accordance

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with 14.6 for the period beginning with such Change Date and ending with and including the date immediately preceding the next Change Date.

- 1.2 <u>Amounts and Due Dates of Installments</u>. The amounts and due dates of installments of principal and interest due and payable hereunder shall be determined as below set forth:
 - 1.2.1 <u>Interest Only Installments</u>. Upon the first day of the first calendar month following the date of this Promissory Note and upon the first day of each and every calendar month thereafter, until and including the first day of the month in which the Closing Date occurs and upon the Closing Date, Porrower shall pay to Lender all interest then accrued and unpaid on the principal sum from time to time outstanding hereunder, which has been disbursed pursuant to the Construction Loan and Disbursement Agreement.
 - 1.2.2 <u>Installmen's of Principal and Interest</u>. Beginning with the first Monthly Due Date (as defined in 14.5) following the Closing Date, Borrower shall pay to Lender installments of principal and interest upon each and every Monthly Due Date during the term hereof, through and including the Maturity Date (as defined in 14.4). The amounts of such installments shall be determined as follows.
 - 1.2.2.1 The amount of each monthly installment due and payable upon the first Monthly Due Date following the Closing Date and upon the next Fifty Nine (59) Monthly Due Dates thereafter shall be the amount (determined by Lender) which shall be sufficient to repay in full, by the Maturity Date, the outstanding principal balance owing hereunder on the Closing Date, together with interest thereon at the rate set forth in 1.1.2, in equal monthly installments.
 - 1.2.2.2 The amount of each monthly installment (other than the Final Installment as defined in 1.2.2.3) due and payable upon each of the twelve Monthly Due Dates following each Change Date shall be, as determined by Lender in Lender's sole discretion, either (i) the amount previously determined by Lender to be due

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and payable upon the Monthly Due Date coinciding with such Change Date or (ii) the amount (determined by Lender) which shall be sufficient to repay in full, by the Maturity Date, the outstanding principal balance owing hereunder on such Change Date, together with interest thereon at the Variable Interest Rate established for such Change Date, in equal monthly installments.

1.2.2.3 Borrower shall pay to Lender, on the Maturity Date, a final installment (herein referred to as "Final Installment") of all DOOP TI amounts then owing and unpaid under this Promissory Note, including (i) the full unpaid balance of the principal sum, (ii) all accrued and unpaid interest, (iii) any penalties payable under the terms of this Promissory Note. Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, instead of making the payment on the Maturity Date as described above, Borrower may be permitted by Lender, in Lender; sole discretion, to continue to pay monthly installments in an amount that is at least equal to the amount of the last monthly installment preceding the Maturity Date, as determined in 1.2.2.2, until all amounts owing and unpaid under this Promissory Note, including (i) the full unpaid balance of the principal sum, (ii) all accrued and unpaid interest, (iii) any penalties payable under the terms of this Promissory Note, are paid in full; provided that in no event shall the amount of any such σ onthly installment payable on or after the Maturity Date be less than the amount (determined by Lender) which shall be sufficient to repay in tall, by the date that is twelve (12) months after the Maturity Date, the outstanding principal balance owing hereunder on the last Change Date preceding such monthly installment, together with interest thereon at the Variable Interest Rate established for such Change Date, in equal monthly installments; and provided further that, until such outstanding amounts are paid in full, interest and penalties shall continue to be determined and accrue and be payable on all such outstanding amounts as otherwise provided under the terms of this Promissory Note.

2. <u>Application of Payments</u>. All payments on account of the indebtedness evidenced by this Promissory Note shall be first applied to the payment of late charges, if any, due and

payable, then to accrued but unpaid interest, and the excess remaining thereafter shall be credited to principal.

- 3. <u>Place of Payment</u>. All payments hereunder shall be made to Lender at P.O. Box 229009, St. Louis, Missouri 63122-9009, or at such other place as the Lender may from time to time designate in writing, delivered or mailed to the Borrower.
- Prepayment. Subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, Borrower reserves the 4. right to prepay this Promissory Note in whole, or in part, on any installment payment date. Any such prepayment shall be first applied against accrued but unpaid interest, and the excess, if any, shall be applied gainst principal, in the inverse order of actual maturity of installments hereunder (i.e., shall be first applied against the final monthly installment). No such partial prepayment shall relieve Porrower of its obligation to pay the next, and subsequent, monthly installment(s) hereunder until the entire indebtedness, together with interest, has been paid in full. If any such prepayment is made by the Closing Date, or within Sixty (60) months from the Closing Date, then such prepayment shall be subject to a prepayment penalty of two percent (2%) of the amount of such prepayment if it is made, in whole or in part, with funds borrowered by the Borrower either (i) from any source other than Lender, whether secured or unsecured and whether from a commercial lending institution or from one or more individuals or (ii) from Lender unless the amount of funds borrowed from Lender exceeds the amount of such prepayment by such amount as shall be established in Lender's procedures applicable to refinancing loans as in effect from time to time.
- 5. <u>Security</u>. This Promissory Note is secured by a deed of trust or mortgage executed as of the same date this Promissory Note has been signed, on real estate situated in the County of Cook, State of Illinois.
- 6. <u>Dissolution, Merger, Use of Security</u>. If Borrower is a member congregation of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, 6.1 shall apply. If Borrower is recognized as a Recognized Service Organization of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, 6.2 shall apply. If Borrower is neither a member congregation nor a Recognized Service Organization of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, 6.3 shall apply.
 - 6.1 <u>Member Congregation</u>. In the event that Borrower shall be dissolved, merge with any other congregation, cease to be a member congregation of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, or cease to use the real estate subject to the aforementioned deed of trust or mortgage for the Borrower's regular worship

services, or for its school, parsonage, teacherage, or other religious purposes, the entire principal sum remaining unpaid hereunder, together with accrued interest, may be declared immediately due and payable at the option of the Lender.

- Recognized Service Organization. In the event that Borrower shall be dissolved, merge with any other corporation or entity, cease to be recognized by The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod as a Recognized Service Organization, or cease to use the real estate subject to the aforementioned deed of trust or mortgage for the religious, charitable, or educational purposes of the Borrower, the entire principal sum remaining unpaid hereunder, together with accrued interest, may be designed immediately due and payable at the option of Lender.
- 6.3 Other Entities. In the event that Borrower shall be dissolved, merge with any other corporation or entity, cease to be an auxiliary, an agency or a part of The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, or cease to use the real estate subject to the aforementioned deed of trust or mortgage for the religious, charitable, or educational purposes of the Borrower, the entire principal sum remaining unpaid hereunder, together with accrued interest, may be declared immediately due and payable at the option of Lender.
- 7. <u>Further Borrowing</u>. In the event that Porrower shall, subsequent to the date hereof, engage in further borrowing, or become voluntarily incepted to any other lender, without the written consent of the Lender, the entire principal sum remaining unpaid hereunder, together with accrued interest, may be declared immediately due and payable at the option of the Lender.
- 8. <u>Default in Payment or Performance</u>. The entire principal sun remaining unpaid hereunder, together with accrued interest, may be declared immediately due and payable at the option of the Lender in the event of any of the following: (i) default in the payment of any installment of principal or interest when due in accordance with the terms hereof, (ii) default in the performance of any agreement contained in the Construction Loan and Disbursement Agreement (the terms of which are hereby incorporated by reference) or the mortgage or deed of trust securing payment of this Promissory Note, or (iii) default in the performance of any agreement given by Borrower in favor of Lender including, but not limited to, any agreement contained in any other promissory note, mortgage, deed of trust, assignment, pledge, security agreement, or guaranty.

- 9. <u>Late Charge</u>. If any installment hereunder, or any portion thereof, is not paid when due, whether at stated maturity or by declaration, a late charge penalty of two percent (2%) of such past due amount shall be added to the amounts due hereunder, except that such late charge penalty shall not exceed the maximum amount permitted by law. Should interest not be paid when due, it shall thereafter bear like interest as the principal, but such unpaid interest so compounded shall not exceed an amount equal to simple interest on the unpaid principal at the maximum rate permitted by law.
- 10. No Waiver. No delay, omission or indulgence by Lender in exercising or enforcing any rights or remedies shall impair or affect the same or be construed to be a waiver of or acquiescence in any default. Any single or partial exercise of any rights or remedies shall not preclude any other or Further exercise thereof. No waiver by the Lender shall be valid unless in writing signed by said Lender, and then only to the extent specifically set forth in said writing.
- 11. <u>Time is of the Essence</u>. Time for the payment and performance of each and all of the obligations of the Borrower shall be of the essence hereof.
- 12. <u>Assignment</u>. The terms and provisions of this Promissory Note shall inure to the benefit of any assignee, transferee, or holder or rollers hereof, and, in the event of any transfer or assignment of this note, each and all of the rights, remedies, powers, privileges and benefits herein granted the Lender shall automatically be vested in the assignee, transferee, holder or holders.
- 13. <u>Waiver of Presentment, Protest, Notice</u>. Borrower and all endorsers hereof severally waive presentment for payment, protest, notice of non-payment and of protest and agree to pay all reasonable costs of collection, including attorneys' fees.
- 14. <u>Definitions</u>. For purposes of this Promissory Note, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:
 - 14.1 "Change Date" shall mean the 60th Monthly Due Date after the Closing Date and every twelfth Monthly Due Date thereafter.
 - 14.2 "Closing Date" shall mean that date thirty days (or earlier, if Lender notifies Borrower of an earlier date), following the earlier of the Date of Completion or the Second Anniversary Date.

"Second Anniversary Date" shall mean that date which is two years following the date of execution of this Promissory Note.

"Date of Completion" shall mean the date of issue of the occupancy permit or similar authorization to occupy and use the facilities on the real estate subject to the mortgage or deed of trust referred to in Paragraph 5, which facilities are to be constructed with the proceeds of the loan evidenced by this Promissory Note and disbursed pursuant to the Construction Loan and Disbursement Agreement.

- 14.3 "Construction Loan and Disbursement Agreement" shall mean the agreement executed by Borrower and Lender as of the same date this Promissory Note has been signed under the terms of which the proceeds of the loan evidenced by this Promissory Note are to be disbursed.
- 14.4 "Maturity Dete" shall mean the Monthly Due Date of the 240th calendar month following the Closing Date.
- 14.5 "Monthly Due Date" shall mean that date in each month following the Closing Date that falls upon the same numerical day of the month as the Closing Date. However, if the Closing Date is later in a month than the 28th day of the month, then the Monthly Due Date for February shall be the 28th day of February. Further, if the Closing Date is the 31st day of a month, then the Monthly Due Date shall fall on the 30th day in those months having only 30 days.
- 14.6 "Variable Interest Rate" shall mean that rate on interest, per annum, determined for each Change Date by Lender, adding up to (as it determines) two percentage points to Lender's Cost of Funds. Lender's Cost of Funds is the weighted average annual rate of interest, determined by Lender on a date selected by it, based upon the interest and other costs payable on or with respect to such of its outstanding investment and other obligations as shall be determined by Lender pursuant to Lender's lending procedures as in effect from time to time.
