That on and after July 12, 2002, the Owners owned the following described land in Cook County, State of Illinois, to wit:



Any credits due Owners have been applied, leaving due but unpaid and owing to the Claimant, after allowing all credits, the sum of Seventeen Thousand One Hundred Eighty Dollars and Thirty Four Cents (\$17,180.34) for which, with interest, and to the extent permitted by law, costs and attorneys' fees, the claimant claims a lien on said land and improvements.
