This deed is subject to all rights, easements, covenants, conditions,



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restrictions and reservations contained in said Declaration the same as through the provisions of said Declaration were recited and stipulated at length herein.

Grantor reserves to itself and its beneficiary, and their successors and assigns, and Grantee hereby grants to Grantor, the right to repurchase the Real Estate provided in paragraph 22(b) of the Real Estate Contract dated April 20, 2001 (date of acceptance April 21, 2001), between Grantor and Grantee (the "Real Estate Contract"). The right of repurchase herein reserved by Grantor (i) is hereby subordinated to the rights of the holder of any mortgage or trust deed hereafter placed upon the Real Estate and (ii) shall expire upon the second anniversary of the date of recording of this deed.

Excerpt of Paragraph 22(b) of Real Estate Agreement

If Purchaser shall institute or initiate legal action against Seller or its general partner at any time within two (2) years subsequent to the Closing, then Seller shall have the option to repurchase the Unit from Purchaser. Seller's right shall be exercised by written notice to Purchaser at any time after Purchager commences or joins in legal action against Seller, on the following terms: (i) the price shall be the original Purchase Price, excluding Extras paid by Purchaser, plus or minus prorations of general real estate taxes and monthly assessments; (ii) Purchaser shall convey, by warranty deed, good marketable, and insurable title to the Unit to Seller, or its designee, subject only to the permitted exceptions (excluding acts of Purchaser) existing at Closing and any acts of Seller; (iii) closing of the repurchase shall be effected through an escrow as described in Paragraph 6(c) hereof; and (iv) Purchaser shall bear all costs of the escrow and title insurance in the amount of the original Purchase Price. No adjustment to the original Purchase Price shall be made for the cost of any improvements made by Purchaser to the Unit after the Closing. If Seller notifies Purchaser of its election to repurchase the Unit, then such repurchase shall be closed within thirty (30) days after the giving of Seller's notice of such election. In the event of Seller's repurchase of the Unit, as provided herein, Purchaser agrees to reconvey the Unit to Seller in the same physical condition as at Closing, except for ordinary wear and tear and improvements or betterments made by Purchaser to the Unit. Seller's right of repurchase under this Paragraph 22(b) is hereby subordinated to the rights of the holder of any mo to age or trust deed hereafter placed upon the Unit.
