The powers granted above shall not include the following powers or shall be modified or limited in the following particulars: Said agent shall only be empowered to act if two physicians in writing certify that I am incapable physically or mentally of managing all my arrairs or if I am classified by a governmental authority as being missing and/or detained against my will.

- In addition to the general powers granted above I grant my agent the following specific powers: The power to amend or alter any trust or will that I have executed provided that any change shall not defeat the percentage division I have adopted among those named as original takers in any trust or will that I have executed. Said agent is specifically authorized to make changes that alter when or how said beneficiaries take, clarify provisions, and/or result in less tax being paid, even though said change results in the termination of a contingent beneficiary's interest under any such will or plan.
