

Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any in the following categories is retained (not struck out) in a cavered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in any type of linancial institution from and write checks on anytinancial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal
- (c) Stock and bond transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of socurities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bonds, mutual funds and other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, cartificates and other evidences of ownership poid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by praxy, enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

The agent is authorized to: organize or continue and conduct any business (which term includes, without limitation, any farming, manufacturing, service, mining, retailing or other type of business operation) in any form, whether as a proprietorship, joint veidure, partnership, corporation, trust or other legal entity; and discharge business managers, employees, agents, attorneys, accountants and consultants; and, in general, exercise of powers with respect to business and engage, compensate operations which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (m) Borrowing transactions. The agent is authorized to: borrow money; martgage or pledge any real estate or tangible or the gible personal property as security barrowing which the principal could it present and under no disability.
- (n) Estate transactions.
