DEED

THE GRANTORS, JAMES L. MARTIN and FRANCES MARTIN, his wife, of the County of Cook, State of Illinois, for and in consideration of Ten and no/100ths (\$10.00) dollars, Convey and Warrant unto FRANCES MARTIN and/or JAMES L. MARTIN, Trustees under the FRANCES MARTIN LIVING TRUST, dated March 15, 2000, GRANTEES, (hereinafter referred to as "said trustee," regardless of the number of trustees) and unto all and every successor or successors in trust under said trust agreement, the following described real estate in the County of Cook and State of Illinois, to wit:

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time or times hereafter, to contract to make leases and to grant options to lease and options to renew leases and options to purchase the whole or any part of the reversion and to contract respecting the manner of fixing the amount of the present or future rentals, to partition or to exchange the Property, or any part thereof, for other real or personal property, to grant easements or charges of any kind, to release, convey or assign any right, title or interest in or about or easement appurtenant to the Property or any part thereof, and to deal with the property and every part thereof in all other ways and for such other considerations as it would be lawful for any person owning the same to deal with the same, whether similar to or different from the ways above specified, at any time or times hereafter.

In no case shall any party dealing with my Trustee in relation to the Property, or to whom the Property or any part thereof shall be conveyed, contracted to be sold, leased or mortgaged by my Trustee, be obliged to see the application of any purchase money, rent, or money borrowed or advanced on the Property, or be obliged to see that the terms of this trust have been complied with, or be obliged to inquire into the necessity or expediency of any act of my Trustee, or be obliged or privileged to inquire into any of the terms of said trust agreement; and every deed, trust deed, mortgage, lease or other instrument executed by my Trustee conveyance, lease or other instrument, (a) that at this time of the delivery thereof the trust created by this indenture and by the trust agreement was in full force and effect, (b) that such conveyance or other instrument was executed in accordance with the trusts, conditions and limitations contained in this indenture and in the trust agreement or in some amendment thereof and binding upon all beneficiaries thereunder, (c) that my Trustee was duly authorized and empowered to execute and deliver every such deed, trust deed, lease, successors in trust have been properly appointed and are fully vested with all the title, estate, rights, powers, authorities, duties and obligations of his, his or their predecessors in trust.

The interest of each and every beneficiary hereunder and of all persons claiming under them or any of them shall be only in the earnings, avails and proceeds arising from the sale or other disposition of the real estate, and such interest is hereby declared to be such, but only an interest in the earnings, avails and proceeds thereof as aforesaid.


To have and to hold, the Property together with all and singular, the rights, privileges, appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto Grantee and unto Grantee's successors-in-interest and assigns forever.

And the said grantors hereby expressly waive and release any and all right or benefit under and by virtue of any and all statutes of the state in which said property is located, providing for the exemption of homesteads from sale on execution or otherwise.



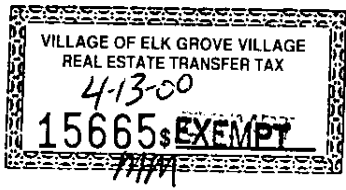

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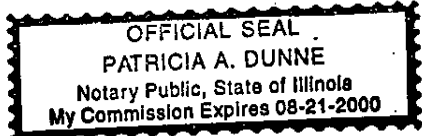
