Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, an isomores are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, naterials and the cost exceeds \$5,000.00.
