Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the status sy short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the spatitory short form power of and ney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the following categories is retained (not street got) in a statutory property power form, the affect wil be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with security to the types of property and transactions covered by the remined entegory, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that expens on the face of the form.
