### CONSENT JUDGMENT

This cause coming on for hearing upon the Petition for Entry of Consent Judgment filed by The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd., former counsel of record for Respondent Yamur Williams, the Court having reviewed said Petition and Affidavit of Respondent Yamur Williams; the Court finding that it has jurisdiction of the parties and of the subject matter, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

THE COURT FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd. has fully complied with General Rule 98 D 3 and that its Fee Petition contains the requisite documents of: affidavit of attorney, copies of signed retainer agreement for legal services and itemized statements for all of professional services rendered, statement of client's rights and responsibilities, and notice of alternative dispute resolution.

(2) Respondent Yamur Williams has agreed that a consent judgment may be entered in the amount of \$5,812.75; that Respondent Yamur Williams has acknowledged receipt of the itemized billings sent to him, detailing hourly costs, time spent and tasks performed and that Respondent Yamur Williams has acknowledged that he is aware of his right to a hearing in

connection with entry of this Consent Judgment and has waived it; that Respondent Yamur Williams has acknowledged that he is aware of his right to be represented by counsel other than The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd., in connection with entry of this Consent Judgment and that he has waived it; and that Respondent Yamur Williams has the right to be present in open court at the time of the presentation of the Petition for Entry of Consent Judgment and the entry of this Consent Judgment and that he has waived that right.

(3) By agreement of the parties, this Court finds that the professional legal services were rendered pursuant to the signed retainer agreement, and were reasonable and necessary in the representation of Respondent Yamur Williams; and further that the compensation awarded herein is just, reasonable and fair.

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) Judgment is entered in favor of former counsel of record The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd. and against Respondent Yamur Williams in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWELVE DOLLARS AND 75/100 (\$5,812.75).

(2) Respondent Yamur Williams agrees to pay said amount to former counsel The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd. as follows: In equal monthly installment payments of \$50.00, the first to be made no later than 5/15/03, 2003, and on the 15th day of each month thereafter until the agreed judgment balance has been paid in full.

(3) Former counsel of record The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd. agrees to stay supplemental proceedings to enforce said judgment for so long as Respondent Yamur Williams continues to make monthly installment payments in a timely manner.


(4) Should Respondent default in making any installment payment due, or should any installment payment be dishonored for any reason, The Law Offices of Jeffery M. Leving, Ltd. agrees to provide written notice of default to Respondent Yamur Williams, via his then-current counsel of record, and to allow ten (10) days to Respondent Yamur Williams to cure any such default; however, at no time shall this judgment be considered impaired or stayed within the meaning of Illinois Supreme Court Rules 281 through 281, inclusive.


(5) Respondent Yamur Williams may prepay all or part of any payments due or to become due without penalty.
