## AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PRELIMINARY AND FINAL APPROVAL OF A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT AND A VARIATION FROM THE ARLINGTON HEIGHTS MUNICIPAL CODE

SECTION ONE: That a planned unit development for an existing fire station is hereby granted for the following legally described property:

Lot 1 in the resubdivision of Lot 9 in the resubdivision of part of Lot 1 and all of Lots 2 through 5, both inclusive, in Arlington Industrial and Research Center Unit 1, according to the plat of said resubdivision of Lot 9 recorded Septembe: 7, 1972 as Document No. 22041915 in the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 42 North, Range 11 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

SECTION FOUR: That the approval of the planned unit development granted in SECTION ONE of this ordinance shall be effective for a period no longer than 24 months from the date of this ordinance, unless construction has begun or such approval has been extended by the President and Board of Trustees during that period.

SECTION FIVE: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law and shall be recorded by the Village Clerk in the office of the Recorder of Cook County.
