

providing the Rents collected by the Security Instrument, (v) Lender, Lender's agents or any
 and then to the sums secured by the Security Instrument, (vi) Lender, Lender's agents or any
 maintenance costs, insurance premiums, taxes, assessments and other charges on the Property,
 not limited to, attorney's fees, receiver's premiums on receiver's bonds, repair and
 the costs of taking control of and managing the Property and collecting the Rents, including, but
 to Lender or Lender's agents upon Lender's written demand to the tenant; (vii) unless applicable
 Security Interest; (iii) Borrower agrees that each tenant of the Property shall pay all Rents due and unpaid
 by Borrower as trustee for the benefit of Lender only, to be applied to the sums secured by the
 and not an assignment for additional security only.

If Lender gives notice of default to Borrower: (i) all Rents received by Borrower shall be held
 payable. Borrower authorizes Lender or Lender's agents to collect the Rents, and agrees that each
 tenant of the Property shall pay the Rents to Lender or Lender's agents. However, Borrower shall
 receive the Rents until (i) Lender has given Borrower notice of default pursuant to Section 22 of
 the Security Instrument and (ii) Lender has given notice to the tenant(s) that the Rents are to be
 paid to Lender or Lender's agent. This assignment of Rents constitutes an absolute assignment
 of the Rents until (i) Lender has given notice to the tenant(s) that the Rents are to be
 received by Lender only, to be applied to the sums secured by the Security Instrument for
 and held by Lender only, to be applied to the sums secured by the Security Instrument for
 and held by Lender only.
