AGREED ORDER DISMISSING CLAIMS
AND ENTERING JUDGMENT

The plaintiff, the United States of America, by its undersigned counsel, Douglas W. Snoeyenbos, and the defendants, Stanley J. Gaynor, Jo Ann Gaynor (both individually and in her capacity as Trustee of the Gaynor Children's Trust), by their undersigned counsel, Stuart K. Taussig, and the Illinois Department of Revenue, by its undersigned counsel, James Newbold, agree as follows:

- 1) judgment should be entered in favor of the United States on the United States' claim for a money judgment against Stanley Gaynor based on unpaid 1992 federal income taxes, penalties, and interest, in the amount of \$3,842,382.81, plus interest and other statutory additions accruing from and after June 30, 2003, less credits applied

after that date;

2) the claim of the United States for foreclosure of its federal tax lien associated with the unpaid 1992 federal income tax liability of Stanley Gaynor against the real property at 321 Sunset Drive, Winnetka, Illinois, PIN 05-21-411-011-000, record title to which is held by LaSalle Bank National Association, as successor trustee to Mid-America National Bank of Chicago, as Trustee of Illinois Land Trust No. 1542, the beneficial interest in which is in the name of Jo Ann Gaynor, is dismissed with prejudice;

3) the claim of the United States for foreclosure of its federal tax lien associated with the unpaid 1992 federal income tax liability of Stanley Gaynor against the real property described as "Lots 62 and 63 in Shenandoah Unit No. 8, of Branigar's Galena Territory, Jo Daviess County, Galena, Illinois," PIN 43-08-108-06200 and 43-08-108-06300, record title to which is held by Jo Ann Gaynor, is dismissed with prejudice;

4) the claim of the United States against Jo Ann Gaynor as Trustee of the Gaynor Children's Trust, and/or against the Gaynor Children's Trust, is dismissed with prejudice;

5) the Illinois Department of Revenue's claims for a money judgment against Stanley Gaynor and for foreclosure of its liens, which are based on unpaid 1992 state income taxes, including interest and penalties, are dismissed as having been settled and satisfied in full. The State of Illinois' lien recorded against Stanley Gaynor as document number 96607571 with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds, is hereby released and Stanley Gaynor is authorized to record a copy of this Agreed Order Dismissing Claims and Entering Judgment with the Recorder of Deeds to effectuate the

release of record;


6) the counterclaim of Jo Ann Gaynor to quiet title is dismissed without prejudice;
