 - 2. In addition to the powers granted above, I grant my agent the following powers:

My agent shall have the right by written instrument to delegate any or all of the foregoing powers involving discretionary decision-making powers to any person or persons my agent may select, but such designation may be amended or revoked by my agent (including any successor) named by me who is acting under this power of attorney at the time of reference.

 - 5. This power of attorney shall become effective upon my signature and execution.
 - 6. This power of attorney shall terminate on October 23, 2003.
