At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, refilled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other decreases are appropriated as the control of the relation of the control of the relation of the re deeds or trust, security deeds, security agreements, mancing statements, communition statements, instruments or turner assurance, certification, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or destrable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the items and security interests created by this Mortgage as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Environmental Default. Fallure of any party to comply with or parform when due any term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in any environmental agreement executed in connection with the Property.

Compliance Default. Fallure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents.

Default in Favor of Third Parties. Should Borrower or any Granfor default under any loan, extension of credit, security agreement, purchase or sales agreement, or any other agreement, in tavor of any other creditor or person that may materially affect any of Borrower's property or Borrower's or any Granfor's ability to repay the Loans or perform their respective obligations under this Mortgage or any of the Related Documents.

Faire Statements. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is false or misteading in any material respect, either now or at the time made or furnished.

Insolvency. The dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business, the insolvency of Grantor, the appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, any type of creditor workout, or the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor.

Foreclosure, Forfelture, stc. Commencement of foreclosure or forfelture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossed on any other method, by a ny meditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good tent or pute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure or forefetture proceeding, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surely bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any bleach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided thure in, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the Indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or becomes incompetent.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrance of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, its obtains no eny other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grunts reported to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Person a Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, with sat notice to Grat for, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above "ender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-far' to endows instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by traints or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the damand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver

Mortgages in Possession. Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by tender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, ubtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title Insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address.
