2. OBLIGATIONS. This Florigage shall secure the payment and partormance of all of Borrower's and Grantor's present and future, indeptedness, liabilities, obligations and cover antis (cumulatively "Obligations") to Lender pursuant to:

- 3. PURPOSE. This Mortgage and the Obligations described herein are executed and incurred for consumer purposes.
- 4. The total amount of indebtedness secured by this Mortgage under the promissory note or agreement (the "NOTE") secured hereby may increase or decrease from time to time, but the total of all such indebtedness, and secured shall not exceed \$.129,500,00 plus interest, collection costs, and amounts secured to protect the iten of this Mortgage. To here secured hereby evidences a "Revolving Credit" as defined in 815 ILCS 2054.1. The lien of this Mortgage secures payment of any existing indebtedness and future advance made on the date of the execution of this Mortgage, wi hout regard to whether or not there is any advance made at the time this Mortgage is executed and without regard to whether or not there is any indebtedness or istal ding at the time any advance is made.
- 5. EXPENSES. To the extent permitted by law, this Mortgage secures the rensyment of all amounts expended by Lander to perform Grantor's covenants under this Mortgage or to maintain, preserve, or dispose of the Property, including but not limited to, amounts expended for the payment of taxes, special assessments, or insurance on the Property, plus interest thereon.
 - 6. REPRESENTATIONS, WARRANTIES AND COVENANTS. Grantor represents, y atrants and covenants to Londer that:
 - (a) Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens, security interests, or or obserces and claims except for this Mortgage and liens and encumbrances of record;
 - (b) Neither Grantor nor, to the best of Grantor's knowledge, any other party has u.m., generated, released, discharged, stored, or disposed of any "Hazardous Materials" as defined herein, in connection with the Property or transported any "Hazardous Materials to or from the Property. Grantor shall not commit or permit such actions to be taken in the future. The term "Hazardous Materials" at all mean any hazardous waste, toxio substances, or any other substance, material, or waste which is or becomes regulated by any governmental unthority including, but not limited to, (i) petroleum; (ii) Iriable as bestos; (iii) polychlorinated biphonyls; (iv) those substances, materials or wester, designated as a "hazardous substance" pursuant to Section 311 of the Clean Water Act or listed pursuant to Section 307 of the Clean Water Act or any arrendments or replacements to these statutes; (v) those substances, materials or wastes defined as a "hazardous waste" pursuant to Section 1004 of the "resource Conservation and Recovery Act or any amendments or replacements to that statute; or (vi) those substances, materials or wastes defined as ""hezardous substance" pursuant to Section 101 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, or any amendments or replacements to that statute or any other similar statute, rule, regulation or ordinance now or hereafter in effect;
 - (c) Grantor has the right and is duly authorized to execute and perform its Obligations under this Morro go and these actions do not and shall not conflict with the provisions of any statute, regulation, ordinance, rule of law, contract or other agreement which help be binding on Grantor at any time;
 - (d) No action or proceeding is or shall be pending or threatened which might materially affect the Property; and
 - (e) Grantor has not violated and shall not violate any statute, regulation, ordinance, rule of law, contract or other articlement which might materially affect the Property (including, but not limited to, those governing Hazardous Materials) or Lendor's rights or interest in the Property oursuant to this Mortgage.
- 7. TRANSFERS OF THE PROPERTY OR BENEFICIAL INTERESTS IN BORROWERS. On sale or transfer to any person without the prior written approval of Lander of all or any part of the real property described in Schedule A, or any interest therein, or of all or any beneficial interest in Borrower or Brantor (if Borrower or Grantor is not a natural person or persons but is a corporation, partnership, trust, or other legal entity). Lender may, at Lender's option declare the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable, and Lander may invoke any remediate permitted by the promissory note or other agreement or by this Mortgage, unless otherwise prohibited by federal law.
- 8. INQUIRIES AND NOTIFICATION TO THIRD PARTIES. Grantor hereby authorizes Lender to contact any third party and make any inquiry pertaining to Grantor's financial condition or the Property. In addition, Lender is authorized to provide oral or written notice of its interest in the Property to any third party.
- 9. INTERFERENCE WITH LEASES AND OTHER AGREEMENTS. Grantor shall not take or fail to take any action which may cause or permit the termination or the withholding of any payment in connection with any lease or other agreement ["Agreement") pertaining to the Property. In addition, Grantor without Lender's prior written consent, shall not: (a) collect any monies payable under any Agreement more than one month in advance; (b) modify any Agreement; (c) assign or allow a liber, security interest or other encurrence to be placed upon Grantor's right, title and interest in and to any Agreement or the announts payable thereunder; or (d) terminate or cancel any Agreement except for the compayment of any sum or other material breach by the other party thereto. If Grantor receives at any time any written communication asserting a default by Grantor under an Agreement or purporting to terminate or cancel any Agreement, Grantor shall promptly forward a copy of such communication. (and any subsequent communications relating thereto) to Lender.
- 10. COLLECTION OF INDEBTEDNESS FROM THIRD PARTY. Lender shall be entitled to notify or require Grantor to notify any third party (including, but not limited to, lessees, licensees, governmental authorities and insurance companies) to pay Lender any indebtedness or obligation owing to Grantor with respect to the Proporty (cumulatively "indebtedness") whether or not a default exists under this Mortgage. Grantor shall diligently collect the indebtedness owing to Grantor from these third parties until the giving of such notification. In the event that Grantor possesses or receives possession of any instrument or other remittances with respect to the Indebtedness following the giving of such notification or if the instruments or other remittances constitute the prepayment of any indebtedness or the payment of any insurance or condemnation proceeds. Grantor shall hold such instruments and other remittances in trust for Lender apart from its other property, endorse the instruments and other remittances. Lender shall be entitled, but not required to collect (by legal proceedings or otherwise), extend the time for payment, compromise, exchange or release any obligor or collateral upon, or otherwise settle any of the indebtedness whether or not an event of default exists under this Agreement.
