JUDGMENT ORDER

Now comes the Petitioner, THE COUNTY OF COOK, by BERNARD CAREY, State's Attorney, and MERCER COOK Assistant States Attorney,

And it appearing to the Court that pursuant to the Illinois High-way Code, Petitioner heretofore on Sept. 8, 1976 filed its Petition to Condemn to have the just compensation ascertained, and to acquire and pay for the fee simple title to certain property necessary to construct and improve a certain highway as described in said petition.

And this cause having been set for trial this day to ascertain the just compensation to be paid for the property sought to be acquired, as herein described, and the Court being fully advised in the premises, and having heard and considered the testimony, both oral and documentary, and the arguments and representations of counsel in open court, finds and determines that the just compensation to be paid by the Potitioner herein to the owners for the fee simple title to the parcels or tracts
