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Together with all buildings, improvements, fixtures or appurtenances now or hereafter erected thereon or placed thereon, including all apparatus, equipment, fixtures or articles, whether in single units or centrally controlled, used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration, ventilation or other services, and any other thing now or hereafter, therein or thereon, the furnishing of which by tenants to lessees is customary or appropriate, including screens, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, screen doors, in-a-door hoods, awnings, water heaters (all of which are intended to be and are hereby declared to be and are hereby declared to be a part of said real estate whether physically attached thereto or not); and also together with all easements and the rents, issues and profits of said premises, which are hereby pledged, assigned, transferred and set over unto the Mortgagee, whether now due or hereafter to become due as provided hereby; and all of the foregoing, together with said real estate (or leasehold estate if this Mortgage is on a leasehold) are herein referred to as the "Property". A. (1) To pay the indebtedness and the interest thereon as stated in said Agreement, or according to any agreement extending the time of payment thereon; (2) To pay when due and before any person at any time all taxes, special taxes, special assessments, water charges, and sewer service charges against the Property (including those heretofore due), and to furnish Mortgagee, upon request, duplicate receipts therefor, and all such items extended against the Property shall be conclusively deemed valid for the purpose of this requirement; (3) To keep the improvements now or hereafter upon the Property insured against damage by fire hazards included within the term "extended coverage," and such other hazards as the Mortgagee may require to be insured against and to provide public liability insurance and such other insurance as the Mortgagee may require, until said indebtedness is fully paid, or in case of foreclosure, until expiration of the period of redemption, for the full insurable value thereof, in such companies and in such forms as shall be satisfactory to the Mortgagee; such insurance policies shall remain with the Mortgagee during said period or periods, and contain the usual clause making them payable to the Mortgagee; and in case of foreclosure sale payable to the owner of the certificate of sale, owner of any deficiency, any receiver or redemptionman, or any grantee in a deed pursuant to foreclosure; and in case of loss under such policies, the Mortgagee is authorized to adjust, collect and compromise, in its discretion, all claims thereunder and to execute and deliver on behalf of the Mortgagee all necessary proofs of loss, receipts, vouchers, releases and acquittances required to be signed by the insurance companies, and the Mortgagee agrees to sign, upon demand, all receipts, vouchers and releases required of it to be signed by the Mortgagee for such purposes, and the Mortgagee is authorized to apply the proceeds of any insurance claim in the restoration of the Property or upon the indebtedness hereby secured in its discretion, but monthly payments shall continue until said indebtedness is paid in full; (4) Immediately after destruction or damage, to commence and promptly complete the rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements now or hereafter on the Property, unless Mortgagee elects to apply on the indebtedness secured hereby the proceeds of any insurance covering such destruction or damage; (5) To keep the Property in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from any mechanic's or other lien or claim of lien not expressly authorized in the lien hereof; (6) To comply with the provisions of any lease if this Mortgage is on a leasehold; (7) To perform all obligations under any declaration, covenant, by-laws, regulations, and covenants governing the Property if the Mortgage is on a condominium or a planned unit development; (8) Not to make, suffer or permit any unlawful use of or any nuisance to exist on the Property nor to diminish or impair its value by any act or omission in fact; (9) To comply with all requirements of law with respect to the Property and the use thereof; (10) Not to make, suffer or permit, without the written permission of the Mortgagee being first had and obtained, (a) any use of the Property for any purpose other than that for which it is now used, (b) any alterations, additions, demolition, removal or sale of any improvements, apparatus, appurtenances, fixtures or equipment now or hereafter upon the Property, (c) any purchase on conditional sale, lease or agreement under which title is reserved in the vendor, of any apparatus, fixtures or equipment to be placed in or upon any buildings or improvements on the Property, (d) any sale, assignment or transfer of any right, title or interest in and in the Property or any portion thereof including, but not limited to, any installment contract or articles of agreement for deed, unless otherwise permitted hereunder; (11) To complete

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within a reasonable time any buildings or improvements now or at any time in process of erection upon the Property; (12) To appear in and defend any proceeding which in the opinion of the Mortgagee affects its security hereunder, and to pay all costs, expenses and attorney's fees incurred or paid by the Mortgagee in any proceeding in which it may be made a party defendant by reason of this Mortgage; and (13) To perform all obligations under any prior mortgage or other encumbrance which is senior to this Mortgage and affecting the Property.

H. This Mortgage and the Agreement provide for additional loans which may be made at the option of the Mortgagee and secured by this Mortgage and it is agreed that in the event of such loans the amount thereof may be added to the mortgage debt and shall increase the unpaid balance of the indebtedness evidenced by the Agreement hereby secured by the amount of such loan and shall be a part of said indebtedness under all the terms of the Agreement. In no event, however, shall such additional loans exceed an amount equal to four times the principal amount stated in the Agreement.

C. That in case of failure to perform any of the covenants herein, Mortgagee may do on Mortgagor's behalf everything so covenanted; that said Mortgagee may also do any act it may deem necessary to protect the lien hereof; that Mortgagee will repay upon demand any moneys paid or disbursed by Mortgagee for any of the above purposes and such moneys together with interest thereon at the rate payable from time to time on outstanding principal under the Agreement shall become so much additional indebtedness secured by this Mortgage with the same priority as the original indebtedness and may be included in any judgment for enforcing this Mortgage and be paid out of the rents or proceeds of sale of the Property if not otherwise paid; that it shall not be obligatory upon the Mortgagee to inquire into the validity of any lien, encumbrance or in advancing moneys as above authorized, but nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Mortgagee to advance any moneys for any purpose not to do any act hereunder; and the Mortgagee shall not incur any personal liability because of anything it may do or omit to do hereunder.

D. That it is the intent hereof to secure payment of the indebtedness due under the Agreement whether the entire amount shall have been advanced to the Mortgagor at the date hereof or a later date, or having been advanced, shall have been repaid in part and further advances made at a later date under the terms of this Mortgage and the Agreement.

E. That if all or any part of the Property, or any interest therein, or if the Mortgagor is a land trust, if all or any part of the beneficial interest in said trust is sold, transferred or assigned by its beneficiaries without the prior consent of the Mortgagee, excluding (a) the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this Mortgage, (b) the creation of a purchase money security interest for household appliances, (c) a transfer by devise, descent, or by obligation of law upon the death of a joint tenant, or (d) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, Mortgagee, may, at Mortgagee's option, declare without notice all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable.

Subject to the terms of this paragraph, in the event the ownership of the Property or any part thereof becomes vested in a person other than the Mortgagor, the Mortgagee may, without notice to the Mortgagor, deal with such successors in interest with reference to this Mortgage and the indebtedness hereby secured in the same manner as with the Mortgagor, and may further at one or more stated times for payment of the indebtedness, secured hereby, without discharging or in any way affecting the liability of the Mortgagor hereunder or upon the indebtedness hereby secured.

F. That time is of the essence hereof, and in default he made in performance of any covenant contained herein or in the Agreement, or in making any payment under the Agreement or any extension or renewal thereof, or if proceedings be instituted to enforce any other lien or charge upon any of the Property, or upon the filing of a proceeding in bankruptcy by or against the Mortgagor, or if the Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of his creditors or if his property be placed under control or in custody of any court, or if the Mortgagor abandons any of the Property or in the event of the transfer of, or agreement to transfer, any right, title or interest in the Property or any portion thereof not otherwise permitted hereunder, or if the Mortgagor fails to complete within a reasonable time, any building or buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon the Property, or upon the filing of a suit to condemn all or a part of the Property, then and in any of said events, the Mortgagee is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option, and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgagee hereunder, to declare, without notice all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable, whether such default be remedied by the Mortgagor, and apply toward the payment of the Mortgage indebtedness any indebtedness of the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor and the Mortgagee may also immediately proceed to foreclose this Mortgage, and in any foreclosure a sale may be made of the Property encumbered without offering the several parts separately. That in the event that the ownership of the Property, or any part thereof, becomes vested in a person other than the Mortgagor and any part of the sums secured hereby remain unpaid, and in the further event that the Mortgagee does not elect to declare such sums immediately due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay a reasonable fee to the Mortgagee to cover the cost of sending the records of the Mortgage to show the change of ownership.

G. That upon the commencement of any foreclosure proceeding hereunder, the court in which the suit is filed may, at any time, either before or after sale, and without notice to the Mortgagor, or any party claiming under him, and without regard to the solvency of the Mortgagor or the then value of the Property, or whether the same shall then be occupied by the owner of the equity of redemption as a homestead, appoint a receiver with power to manage and rent and to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Property during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and the statutory period of redemption and such rents, issues and profits, when collected, may be applied before as well as after the sale, towards the payment of the indebtedness, costs, taxes, insurance or other items necessary for the protection and preservation of the Property, including the expenses of such receivership, or on any deficiency judgment whether there be a judgment therefor in personam or not, and if a receiver shall be appointed he shall remain in possession until the expiration of the full period allowed by statute for redemption, whether there be redemption or not, and until the issuance of deed in case of sale, but if no deed be issued, until the expiration of the statutory period during which it may be issued, and no lease of the Property shall be nullified by the appointment or entry in possession of a receiver but he may elect to terminate any lease junior to the lien hereof, and upon the foreclosure of the Property, there shall be allowed and included as an additional indebtedness in the judgment of sale all expenditures and expenses together with interest thereon at the rate of 12% per annum at the rate under the Agreement, whichever is higher, which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorney's fees, Mortgagee's fees, appraiser's fees, survey, outlays for exhibits attached to pleadings, documentary and expert evidence, stenographer's fees, court costs, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to and in such items to be expended after the entry of the judgment, including attorney's fees) procuring all abstracts of title, title searches, title examinations and reports, title insurance policies, Taxors certificates and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may reasonably deem necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to be adduced at any sale held pursuant to such judgment the true title or value of the Property; all of which aforesaid amounts together with interest as herein provided shall be immediately due and payable by the Mortgagor in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate or bankruptcy proceeding to which either party hereto shall be a party by reason of this Mortgage or the Agreement hereby secured; (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure, hereof after the accrual of the right to foreclose, whether or not actually commenced; (c) preparations for the defense of or intervention in any threatened or contemplated suit or proceeding which might affect the Property or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced. In the event of a foreclosure sale of the Property there first shall be paid out of the proceeds thereof all of the aforesaid items, then the entire indebtedness, whether due and payable by the terms hereof, the interest due thereon up to the time of such sale, and the surplus, if any shall be paid to the Mortgagor, and the purchaser shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

H. In case the Property, or any part thereof, shall be taken by condemnation, the Mortgagee is hereby empowered to collect and receive all compensation which may be paid for any of the Property taken or for damages to any of the Property not taken and all condemnation compensation so received shall be forthwith applied by the Mortgagee as it may elect, to the immediate reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, or to the repair and restoration of any of the Property so damaged, provided that any excess over the amount of the indebtedness shall be delivered to the Mortgagor or his assigns.

I. All assessments, rents, issues and profits of the Property are pledged, assigned and transferred to the Mortgagee, whether now due or hereafter to become due, under or by virtue of any lease or agreement for the use or occupancy of the Property, or any part thereof, whether said lease or agreement is written or verbal, and it is the intention hereof (a) to pledge said rents, issues and profits on a party with the Property and not secondarily and such pledge shall not be deemed merged in any foreclosure judgment, and (b) to establish an absolute transfer and assignment to the Mortgagee of all such issues and agreements and all the avails thereunder, together with the right in case of default, either before or after foreclosure sale, to enter upon and take possession of, manage, maintain and operate the Property, or any part thereof, make leases for terms deemed advantageous to it, terminate or modify existing or future leases, collect said avails, rents, issues and profits, regardless of when earned, and use such measure as whether legal or equitable as it may deem proper to enforce collection thereof, employ selling agents or other employees, alter or repair the Property, buy furnishings and equipment therefor when it deems necessary, purchase adequate fire and extended coverage and other forms of insurance as may be deemed advisable, and in general exercise all powers ordinarily incident to absolute ownership, advance or borrow money necessary for any purpose herein stated to secure which a lien is hereby created on the Property and on the income therefrom which lien is prior to the lien of any other indebtedness hereby secured, and out of the income retain reasonable compensation for itself, pay insurance premiums, taxes and assessments, and all expenses of every kind including attorney's fees incurred in the exercise of the powers herein given, and from time to time apply any balance of income not in its sole discretion, needed for the aforesaid purposes, first on the interest and then on the principal of the indebtedness hereby secured, before or after any judgment of foreclosure, and on the deficiency in the proceeds of sale, if any, whether there be a judgment in personam therefor or not. Whenever all of the indebtedness secured hereby is paid, and the Mortgagee, in its sole discretion, feels that there is no substantial uncorrected default in performance of the Mortgagor's agreements herein, the Mortgagee, on satisfactory evidence thereof, shall relinquish possession and pay to Mortgagor any surplus income in its hands. The possession of Mortgagee may continue until

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all interests therein secured hereby by a public sale until the delivery of a deed pursuant to a judgment increasing the lien hereof, but if no deed be issued, then until the expiration of the statutory period during which it may be issued. Mortgagee shall, however, have the discretionary power at any time to refuse to take or to abandon possession of the Property without affecting the lien hereof. Mortgagee shall have all powers, if any, which it might have had without this paragraph. No suit shall be maintainable against Mortgagee based upon acts or omissions relating to the subject matter of this paragraph unless commenced within sixty days after Mortgagee's possession ceases.

J. That each right, power and remedy conferred by this Mortgage or the Agreement upon the Mortgagee is cumulative of every other right or remedy of the Mortgagee, whether herein or by law conferred, and may be enforced concurrently therewith, that no waiver by the Mortgagee of performance of any covenant contained herein or in the Agreement shall thereafter in any manner affect the right of Mortgagee to require or enforce performance of the same or any other of said covenants; that wherever the context hereof requires, the masculine gender, as used herein, shall include the feminine and the neuter, and singular number, as used herein, shall include the plural; that all rights and obligations under this Mortgage shall extend to and be binding upon the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Mortgagor, and the sureties and assigns of the Mortgagee; and that the powers herein mentioned may be exercised as often as occasion therefor arises.

K. Mortgagee may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property, provided that Mortgagee shall give Mortgagor notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefor related to Mortgagee's interest in the Property.

L. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Mortgagee provided for in this Mortgage shall be given by mailing such notice by regular mail, addressed to Mortgagor at the Property address or at such other address as Mortgagor may designate by notice to Mortgagee as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Mortgagee shall be given by certified mail, return receipt requested to Mortgagee's address stated herein or in such other address as Mortgagee may designate by notice to Mortgagor as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this Mortgage shall be deemed to have been given to Mortgagor or Mortgagee when given in the manner designated herein.

M. This Mortgage shall be governed by the law of the State of Illinois. In the event that any provision or clause of this Mortgage or the Agreement conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Mortgage or the Agreement which can be given effect without the conflicting provision and to this end the provisions of the Mortgage and the Agreement are declared to be severable.

N. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Mortgage and termination of the Agreement, Mortgagee shall release this Mortgage.
