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17. Borrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

18. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. 20. Sale of Note; Change of Loan Servicer; Notice of Grievance. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) can be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. A sale might result in a change in the entity (Lnown as the "Loan Servicer") that collects Periodic Payments due under the Note and this Security Instrumer, and performs other mortgage loan servicing obligations under the Note, this Security Instrument, and Applic ole Law.
