Address 5435 Diversey, Chicago Illi<u>nois</u> <u>COOK</u> County; State of <u>Illinois</u> agrees to sell to Buyer at the PURCHASE PRICE of <u>THREE HUNDRED</u> FIFTY THREE THOUSAND Dollars (\$353,000.00) the PROPERTY commonly known as 4309 W. FULLERTON and legally described as follows:

All of the foregoing items shall be 1eft c. the premises, are included in the sale price, and shall be transferred to the Buyer by a Bill of Sale at the time of final ciosing.

THE DEED: 2.

- a. If the Buyer shall first make all the paynents and perform all the covenants and agreements in this Agreement required to be made and performed by said Buyer, at the time and in the manner hereinafter set forth, Seller shall convey or cause to be conveyed to Buyer or nis nominee, by a recordable, stamped general warranty deed with release of homestead rights, good title to the promises subject only to the following "permitted exceptions," if any: (a) General real estate taxes not yet due and payable; (b) Special assessments confirmed after this contract date; (c) Building, building line and use of occupancy restrictions, conditions and covenants of record; (d) Zoning laws and ordinances; (e) Easements for public utilities, (f) Drainage ditches, feeders, laterals and drain tile, pipe or other conduit.
- The performance of all the covenants and conditions herein to be performed by Buyer shall be a condition precedent to Seller's obligation to deliver the deed aforesaid.
- INSTALLMENT PURCHASE: Buyer hereby covenants and agrees to part to Seller at closing or such other person or at such other place as Seller may from time to time designate in writing, the purchase price and interest on the balance of the purchase price remaining from time to time unpaid from the date of initial closing at the rate of eight percent (8 %) per annum, all payable in the manner following to wit:
 - (a) Buyer shall pay at the time of the initial closing, the sum of \$70,600.00;
- (b) The balance of the purchase price, to wit: \$282,400.00 minus prorations as stated in the closing statement to be paid in monthly installments as follows \$1,866.66 due on the 6th Day of August, 2004 and \$1,866.66 due on the 6th day of each month thereafter up to and including the 6th day of December, 2004. Then a fixal payment of the remaining balance due on or before December 31, 2004.

However, if Buyer desires to extend the final payment to June 30, 2005, he may do so by making a request in writing on or before December 15, 2004 and agreeing to pay a fee of \$10,000.00 in additional to any interest. In addition, Buyer shall continue to make payments at the rate of \$1,866.66 on the 6th day of each month beginning January, 2005 and continuing until June, 2005. The final payment of the remaining balance shall then be June 30, 2005.

- (c) Buyer shall pay a 5% late fee penalty if any monthly payment is more than 5 days late.
- (d) All payments received hereunder shall be applied in the following order of priority: first, to interest accrued and owing on the unpaid principal balance of the purchase price; second, to pay before delinquent all taxes and assessments which subsequent to the date of this Agreement may become a lien on the premises; third, and to pay insurance premiums falling due after the date of this Agreement; and fourth, to reduce said unpaid principal balance of the purchase price;

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- CLOSINGS: The "initial closing" shall occur on July 6, 2004 (or on the date, if any, to which said date is 4. extended by reason of subparagraph 8(b) at 5435 W. Diversey, Chicago, Illinois or any other place the parties shall agree upon. "Final closing" shall occur if and when all covenants and conditions herein to be performed by Buyer have been so performed.
- POSSESSION: Possession shall be granted to Buyer at 12:01 a.m. on July 7, 2004 provided that the full 5. down payment minus net prorations due in favor of Buyer, if any, has been paid to Seller in cash or by cashier's or certified check on the initial closing date, and further provided that Buyer on such initial closing date is otherwise not in default hereunder.

PRIOR MORTGAGES: 6.

- (a) Seller reserves the right to keep a mortgage ("prior mortgage") against the title to the premises with a balance including interest not to exceed the balance of the purchase price unpaid at any time under this Agreement, the lien of which prior mortgage shall, at all times notwithstanding that this Agreement is recorded, be prior to the interest that Buyer may have in the premises, and Buyer expressly agrees upon demand to execute and acknowledge together with Seller cay such mortgage or trust deed (but not the notes secured thereby). No mortgage or trust deed placed on said premises reduding any such prior mortgage shall in any way accelerate the time of payment provided for in this Agreement or provide for payment of any amount, either interest or principal, exceeding that provided for under this Agreement, or otherwise be in conflict with the terms and provisions of this Agreement, nor shall such mortgage or trust deed in any way restrict the right of prepayment, if any, given to Buyer under this Agreement.
- (b) Seller shall from time to irre, but not less frequently than once each year and anytime Buyer has reason to believe a default may exist, exhibit to Buyer receipts for payments made to the holders of any indebtedness secured by any such prior mortgage.
- (c) In the event Seller shall fail to nake any payment on the indebtedness secured by a prior mortgage or shall suffer or permit there to be any other breach or default in the terms of any indebtedness or prior mortgage, Buyer shall have the right, but not the obligation, to make such payments or cure such default and to offset the amount so paid or expended including all incidental cos's, e penses and attorney's fees attendant thereto incurred by Buyer to protect Buyer's interest hereunder from the unpaid balance of the purchase price or from the installment payments to be made under this Agreement.
- Prior to the initial closing, Seller shall deliver to Buyer or his agent a spotted survey of SURVEY: the premises, certified by a licensed surveyor, having all corners stake and showing all improvements existing as of this contract date and all easements and building lines. (In the event the promi es is a condominium, only a copy of the pages showing said premises on the recorded survey attached to the Declare uon of Condominium shall be required).

TITLE: 8.

- (a) At least one (1) business day prior to the initial closing, Seller shall furnisher cause to be furnished to Buyer at Seller's expense a commitment issued by a title insurance company licensed to do l'usin ss in Illinois, to issue a contract purchaser's title insurance policy on the current form of American Land Title Association Owner's Policy (or equivalent policy) in the amount of the purchase price covering the date hereof, subject only to: (1) the general exceptions contained in the policy, unless the real estate is improved with a single family dwelling or an apartment building of four or fewer residential units; (2) the "permitted exceptions" set forth in paragraph 2; (3) prior mortgages permitted in paragraph 6; (4) other title exceptions pertaining to liens or encumbrances of a definite or ascertainable amount, which may be removed by the payment of money and which shall be removed at or prior to the initial closing; and (5) acts done or suffered by or judgments against the Buyer, or those claiming by, through or under the Buyer.
- (b) If the title commitment discloses unpermitted exceptions, the Seller shall have thirty (30) days from the date of delivery thereof to have the said exceptions waived, or to have the title insurer commit to insure against loss or damage that may be caused by such exceptions and the initial closing shall be delayed, if necessary, during said 30 day period to allow Seller time to have said exceptions waived. If the Seller fails to have unpermitted exceptions waived, or in the alternative, to obtain a commitment for title insurance specified above as to such exceptions, within the specified time, the Buyer may terminate the contract between the parties, or may elect, upon notice to the Seller within ten (10) days after the expiration of the thirty (30) day period, to take the title as it then is, with the right to deduct from the purchase price, liens or encumbrances of a definite or ascertainable amount. If the Buyer does not

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so elect, the contract between the parties shall become null and void, without further action of the parties, and all monies paid by Buyer hereunder shall be refunded.

- (c) Every title commitment which conforms with subparagraph "a" shall be conclusive evidence of good title therein shown, as to all matters insured by the policy, subject only to special exceptions therein stated.
- (d) If a title commitment discloses judgments against the Buyer which may become liens, the Seller may declare this Agreement null and void and all earnest money shall be forfeited by the Buyer.
- (e) Buyer's taking possession of the premises shall be conclusive evidence that Buyer in all respects accepts and is satisfied with the physical condition of the premises, all matters shown on the survey and the condition of title to the premises as shown to him on or before the initial closing. Seller shall upon said delivery of possession have no further obligation with respect to the title or to furnish further evidence thereof except that Seller shall remove any exception or defect not permitted under paragraph 8(a) resulting from acts done or suffered by, or judgments against the Seller between the initial closing and the final closing.
- 9. AFAD AVIT OF TITLE: Seller shall furnish Buyer at or prior to the initial closing and, again prior to final closing with an Affidavit of Title, covering said dates, subject only to those permitted exceptions set forth in paragraph 2, prior moregages permitted in paragraph 6 and unpermitted exceptions, if any, as to which the title insurer commits to extend insurance in the manner specified in paragraph 8. In the event title to the property is held in trust, the Affidavit of Title required to be furnished by Seller shall be signed by the Trustee and the beneficiary or beneficiaries of said Trust. All parties shall execute an "ALTA Loan and Extended Coverage Owner's Policy Statement" and such other decuments as are customary or required by the issuer of the commitment for title insurance at the initial and final clessings.
- 10. PRORATIONS: Insurance pretiums, general taxes, association assessments and, if final meter readings cannot be obtained, water and other utilities thall be adjusted ratably as of the date of possession. Real estate taxes for the year of possession shall be prorated as on the date of initial closing subject to reproration upon receipt of the actual tax bill.
- 11. ESCROW CLOSING: At the election of Seller or Buyer, upon notice to the other party not less than five (5) days prior to the date of either the initial or final closing, wis transaction or the conveyance contemplated hereby shall be made through escrow with a title company, bank or other institution or an attorney licensed to do business or to practice in the State of Illinois in accordance with the general provisions of an escrow trust covering articles of agreement for deed consistent with the terms of this Agreement. Upon creation of such an escrow, anything in this Agreement to the contrary notwithstanding, installments or payments due there after and delivery of the Deed shall be made through escrow. The cost of the escrow including an ancillary money lender's escrow, shall be paid by the party requesting it.

12. SELLER'S REPRESENTATIONS:

- (a) Seller expressly warrants to Buyer that no notice from any city, village or other governmental authority of a dwelling code violation which existed in the dwelling structure on the premises herein described before this Agreement was executed, has been received by the Seller, his principal or his agent within ten (16) years of the date of execution of this Agreement.
- (b) Seller represents that all equipment and appliances to be conveyed, including but not limited to the following, are in operating condition: all mechanical equipment; heating and cooling equipment; water heaters and softeners; septic, plumbing, and electrical systems; kitchen equipment remaining with the premises and any miscellaneous mechanical personal property to be transferred to the Buyer. Upon the Buyer's request prior to the time of possession, Seller shall demonstrate to the Buyer or his representative all said equipment and upon receipt of written notice of deficiency shall promptly and at Seller's expense correct the deficiency. IN THE ABSENCE OF WRITTEN NOTICE OF ANY DEFICIENCY FROM THE BUYER PRIOR TO THE DATE SPECIFIED FOR INITIAL CLOSING IT SHALL BE CONCLUDED THAT THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE EQUIPMENT IS SATISFACTORY TO THE BUYER AND THE SELLER SHALL HAVE NO FURTHER RESPONSIBILITY WITH REFERENCE THERETO.
- (c) Seller agrees to leave the premises in broom clean condition. All refuse and personal property not to be delivered to Buyer shall be removed from the premises at Seller's expense before the date of initial closing.
 - (d) General disclosures and lead paint disclosures made by the Seller are true and correct.

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- BUYER TO MAINTAIN: Buyer shall keep the improvements on premises and the grounds in as good 13. repair and condition as they now are, ordinary wear and tear excepted. Buyer shall make all necessary repairs and renewals upon said premises including by way of example and not of limitation, interior and exterior painting and decorating; window glass; heating, ventilating and air conditioning equipment; plumbing and electrical systems and fixtures; roof; masonry including chimneys and fireplaces, etc. If, however, the said premises shall not be thus kept in good repair, and in a clean, sightly, and healthy condition by Buyer, Seller may either (a) enter same, himself, or by their agents, servants, or employees, without such entering causing or constituting a termination of this Agreement or an interference with Buyer's possession of the premises, and make the necessary repair and do all the work required to place said premises in good repair and in a clean, sightly, and healthy condition, and Buyer agrees to pay to Seller, as so much additional purchase price for the premises, the expenses of the Seller in making said repairs and in placing the premises in a clean, sightly, and healthy condition; or (b) notify the Buyer to make such repairs and to place said premises in a clean, sightly, and healthy condition within thirty (30) days of such notice (except as is otherwise provided in paragraph 21), and, upon default by Buyer in complying with said notice, then, Seller may avail himself of such remedies as Seller may elect, if any, from those that are by this Agreement or at law or equity provided.
- FIXTURES AT EQUIPMENT: At the time of delivery of possession of the premise to Buyer, Buyer 14. also shall receive possession of the personal property to be sold to Buyer pursuant to the terms of this Agreement as well as of the fixtures and equipment permanently attached to the improvements on the premises, but until payment in full of the purchase price is made none of such personal property, fixtures or equipment shall be removed from the premises without the prior written consent of the Seller.

INSURANCE: 15.

- (a) Buyer shall from and after the time specified in paragraph 5 for possession, keep insured against loss or damage by fire or other casualty, the improvement now and hereafter erected on premises with a company, or companies, reasonably acceptable to Seller in policies conforming to Insurance Service Bureau Homeowners form 3 ("H.O.3") and, also, flood insurance where applicable, with coverage not less than the balance of the purchase price hereof (except that if the full insurable value of such improvements is less than the balance of purchase price, then at such full insurable value) for the benefit of the parties here is and the interest of any mortgagee or trustee, if any, as their interests may appear; such policy or policies shall be held by Seller, and Buyer shall pay the premiums thereon when due.
- (b) In case of loss of or damage to such improvements, wherear before or after possession is given hereunder, any insurance proceeds to which either or both of the parties hareto shall be entitled on account thereof, shall be used (i) in the event the insurance proceeds are sufficient to fully reconstruct or restore such improvements, to pay for the restoration or reconstruction of such damaged or lost improvement, or (ii) in the event the insurance proceeds are not sufficient to fully reconstruct such improvements, then the proceeds of insurance shall be applied to the unpaid balance of purchase price.
- TAXES AND CHARGES: It shall be the Buyer's obligation to pay immediately when due and payable and prior to the date when the same shall become delinquent all general and special taxes, special accessments, water charges, sewer service charges and other taxes, fees, liens, homeowner associations assessments and charges now or hereafter levied or assessed or charged against the premises or any part thereof or any improvements thereon, including those heretofore due and to furnish Seller with the original or duplicate receipts therefore.

BUYER'S INTEREST: 17.

- (a) No right, title, or interest, legal or equitable, in the premises described herein, or in any part thereof, shall vest in the Buyer until the Deed, as herein provided, shall be delivered to the Buyer.
- (b) In the event of the termination of this Agreement by lapse of time, forfeiture or otherwise, all improvements, whether finished or unfinished, whether installed or constructed on or about said premises by the Buyer or others shall belong to and become the property of the Seller without liability or obligation on Seller's part to account to the Buyer therefore or for any part thereof.

LIENS: 18.

(a) Buyer shall not suffer any mechanics' lien, judgment lien or other lien of any nature whatsoever to attach to or be against the property which shall or may be superior to the rights of the Seller.

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(b) Each and every contract for repairs or improvements on the premises aforesaid, or any part thereof, shall contain an express, full and complete waiver and release of any and all lien or claim of lien against the subject premises, and no contract or agreement, oral or written, shall be executed by the Buyer for repairs or improvements upon the premises, except if the same shall contain such express waiver or release of lien upon the part of the party contracting and a copy of each and every such contract shall be promptly delivered to Seller.

19. PERFORMANCE:

- (a) If Buyer (1) defaults by failing to pay when due any single installment or payment required to be made to Seller under the terms of this Agreement and such default is not cured within ten (10) days of written notice to Buyer; or (2) defaults in the performance of any other covenant or agreement hereof and such default is not cured by Buyer within thirty (30) days after written notice to Buyer (unless the default involves a dangerous condition with shall be cured forthwith); Seller may treat such a default as a breach of this Agreement and Seller shall have any one or more of the following remedies in addition to all other rights and remedies provided at law or in equity: (i) maintain an action for any unpaid installments; (ii) declare the entire balance due and maintain an action for such amount; (iii) for eit the Buyer's interest under this Agreement and retain all sums paid as liquidated damages in full satisfaction of any claim against Buyer, and upon Buyer's failure to surrender possession, maintain an action for possession under the Portible Entry and Detainer Act, subject to the rights of Buyer to reinstate as provided in that Act. In the event that the Riccois Mortgage Foreclosure Law shall apply, the parties will proceed in accordance with that Law.
- (b) As additional security in the event of default, Buyer assigns to Seller all unpaid rents, and all rents which accrue thereafter, and in addition to the remedies provided above and in conjunction with any one of them, Seller may collect any rent due and owing and may seek the appointment of receiver.
- (c) If default is based upon the failure to pay taxes, assessments, insurance or liens, Seller may elect to make such payments and add the amount to ne principal balance due, which amounts shall become immediately due and payable by Buyer to Seller.
- (d) Seller may impose and Buyer agrees a pay a late charge not exceeding 5% of any periodic sum due hereunder which Seller elects to accept after the date the sun was due.
- (e) Anything contained in subparagraphs (a) through (d) to the contrary notwithstanding, this Agreement shall not be forfeited and determined, if within 20 days after such written notice of default, Buyer tenders to Seller the entire unpaid principal balance of the Purchase Price and accrued interest then outstanding and cures any other defaults of a monetary nature affecting the premises or monetary claims arising from acts or obligations of Buyer under this Agreement.

DEFAULT, FEES: 20.

- (a) Buyer or Seller shall pay all reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred by the other in enforcing the terms and provisions of this Agreement, including forfeiture or specific performance, in defending any proceeding to which Buyer or Seller is made a party to any legal proceedings as a result of the acts of omissions of the other party.
- (b) (1) All rights and remedies given to Buyer or Seller shall be distinct, separate and cumulative, and the use of one or more thereof shall not exclude or waive any other right or remedy allowed by law. in less specifically waived in this Agreement; (2) no waiver of any breach or default of either party hereunder shall be implied from any omission by the other party to take any action on account of any similar or different breach or default; the payment or acceptance of money after it falls due after knowledge of any breach of this Agreement by Buyer or Scher, or after the termination of Buyer's right of possession hereunder, or after the service of any notice, or after commencement of any suit, or after final judgment for possession of the premises shall not reinstate, continue or extend this Agreement nor affect any such notice, demand or suit or any right hereunder not herein expressly waived.
- NOTICES: All notices required to be given under this Agreement shall be construed to mean notice in writing signed by or on behalf of the party giving the same, and the same may be served upon the other party or his agent personally or by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the parties addressed if to Seller at the address shown on paragraph 1 or if to the Buyer at the address of the premises. Notice shall be deemed made when mailed or served.
- ABANDONMENT: Fifteen days of continual physical absence by Buyer with any installment being unpaid, or removal of the substantial portion of Buyer's personal property with installments being paid, and in either

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case, reason to believe Buyer has vacated the premises with no intent again to take possession thereof shall be conclusively deemed to be an abandonment of the premises by Buyer. In such event, and in addition to Seller's remedies set forth in paragraph 20, Seller may, but need not, enter upon the premises and act as Buyer's agent to perform necessary decorating and repairs and to re-sell the premises outright or on terms similar to those contained in this Agreement with allowance for then existing marketing conditions. Buyer shall be conclusively deemed to have abandoned any personal property remaining on or about the premises and Buyer's interest therein shall thereby pass under this Agreement as a bill of sale to Seller without additional payment by Seller to Buyer.

- 23. SELLER'S ACCESS: Seller may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspection of the premises, provided that Seller shall give Buyer notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefor related to Seller's interest in the premises.
- 24. CALCOLATION OF INTEREST: Interest for each month shall be calculated in arrears at the rate set forth herein on the balance from time to time unpaid for the year then divided by 12. Interest for the period from the date of initial closing ontil the date the first installment is due shall be payable on or before the date of initial closing.
- 25. ASSIGNMENT. The Buyer shall not transfer, pledge or assign this Agreement, or any interest herein or hereunder nor shall the Buyer lease nor sublet the premises, or any part thereof. Any violation or breach or attempted violation or breach of the provisions of this paragraph by Buyer, or any acts inconsistent herewith, shall vest no right, title or interest herein or hereunder, or in the said premises in any such transferee, pledgee, assignee, lessee or sub-lessees, but Seller may acceptable option, declare this Agreement null and void and invoke the provisions of this Agreement relating to for faiture hereof.
- 26. FINAL CLOSING: Buyer shall be entitled to delivery of the Deed of conveyance aforesaid Affidavit of Title and a Bill of Sale to the personal property to be ray sforred to Buyer under this Agreement at any time upon payment of all amounts due hereunder in the form of wire trar sier, cash, cashier's or certified check made payable to Seller, which amount shall be without premium or penalty. At the time Buyer provides notice to Seller that he is prepared to prepay all amounts due hereunder, Seller forthwith either chall produce and record at his expense a release deed for the prior mortgage, or obtain a currently dated loan repaymen. 1 etter reflecting the amount necessary to discharge and release the prior mortgage. Seller shall have the right to repay and discharge such prior mortgage in whole or in part from sums due hereunder from Buyer. The repayment of the prior not tgage shall be supervised and administered by Buyer's mortgage lender, if any. Upon repayment of the prior mortgage Seller shall receive the canceled note and a release deed in form satisfactory for recording which, shall be delivered to Buyer. Seller shall give Buyer a credit against the balance of the purchase price for the cost of recording such release. In the event Buyer does not have a mortgage lender, then the delivery of the canceled note to Seller shall be simular cous with the delivery of the Deed from Seller to Buyer, and to facilitate the delivery of documents and the payment of the prior mortgage and the balance of the amount due hereunder, the parties agree to complete such exchange at the offices of the holder of the note secured by the prior mortgage. At the time of delivery of the Deed, Buyer and Seller shall execute and furnish such real estate transfer declarations as may be required to comply with State, County or local la v. Seller shall pay the amount of any stamp tax then imposed by State or County law on the transfer of title to Buyer, and Buyer shall pay any such stamp tax and meet other requirements as then may be established by any local ordinance with regard to the transfer of title to buyer unless otherwise provided in the local ordinance.
- 27. RECORDING: The parties shall record this Agreement or a memorandum thereof at Buyer's expense.
- 28. RIDERS: The provisions contained in any rider attached hereto are and shall for all purposes be deemed to be part of this Agreement as though herein fully set forth.
- 29. CAPTIONS AND PRONOUNS: The captions and headings of the various sections or paragraphs of this Agreement are for convenience only, and are not to be construed as confining or limiting in any way the scope or intent of the provisions hereof. Whenever the context requires or permits, the singular shall include the plural, the plural shall include the singular and the masculine, feminine and neuter shall be freely interchangeable.
- 30. PROVISIONS SEVERABLE: The unenforceability or invalidity of any provision or provisions hereof shall not render any other provision or provisions herein contained unenforceable or invalid.
