Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short form power of air. In your property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the statutory short form power of attorney for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in ony type of financial institution (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust companies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw from and write checks on any financial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Stock and bond transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and self all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stacks, bonds, mutual funds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by proxy, enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.

The agent is authorized to: buy, wit, exchange, assign, convey, settle and exercise commodities futures contracts and call and put options on stocks and stock indices traded on a regulated actions exchange and roll at and receipt for all proceeds of any such transactions; establish or continue option accounts for the principal with any securities or futures broker; and, in general, exercise full powers with respect to commodities and options which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (1) Business operations.
