### SECTION 3-4 OF THE ILLINOIS STATUTORY SHORT FORM POWER OF ATTORNEY FOR PROPERTY LAW (755 ILCS 45/3-4)

§3-4. Explanation of powers manted in the statutory short form power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in its scriptory short form power of altomey for property and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of this following categories is relained (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to grant the age in all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with respect to the types of property and transactions covered by the relained rategory, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interests in every type of property or transaction covered by the granted power at the time of exercise, whether the principal's interests at a direct or indirect, whole or iractional, legal, equitable or contractual, as a joint tenant or tenant in common or held in any other form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory categories (a) through (o) to make gifts of the principal's property, to exercise powers to appoint to others or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to like principal's interests at death under any will, trust, joint tenancy, beneficiary form or contractual arrangement. The agent will be under no duty to exercise granted powers or to assume control of or responsibility for the principal's property or affairs; but when granted powers are exercised, the agent will be required to use due care to act for the benefit of the principal in accordance with the terms of the statutory properly power and will be fiable for negligent exercise. The agent they act in person or through others reasonably employed by the agent for that purpose and will have authority to sign at diseiver all instruments, negotiate and enter into all agreements and do all other acts reasonably necessary to implement the carefase of the powers granted to the agent.

- (a) Real estate transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy, sell, exchange, rent and lease real estate (which term includes, without limitation, real estate subject to a land trust and all beneficial interests in and powers of direction under any land trust); collect all rent, sale proceeds and earnings from 122 estate; convey, assign and accept title to real estate; grant easements, create conditions and release rights of hom stead with respect to real estate; create land trusts and exercise all powers under land trusts; hold, possess, maintain, repair, improve, subdivide, manage, operate and insure real estate; pay, contest, protest end compromise rain estate taxes and assessments; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to real estate which the principal could it present and under no disability.
- (b) Financial institution transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all at counts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust control savings and building and loan associations, credit unions and brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw for and write checks on any financial institution account or deposit; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Slock and bond transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which termincludes, without limitation, stocks, bonds, mutual funds and all other types of unvestment sectionies and financial instruments); collect, hold and salekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, shares, certificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by proxy, enter into voting trusts and consent to limitations on the right to vote; and, in general, exercise any powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (d) Tangible personal property transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell, lease, exchange, collect, possess and take title to all tangible personal property; move, store, ship, restore, maintain, repair, improve, manage, preserve, insure and safekeep langible personal property; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to langible personal property which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (e) Sale deposit box transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, continue and have access to all sale deposit boxes; sign, renew, release or terminate any sale deposit contract; drill or surrender any sale deposit box; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to sale deposit-matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.

The agent is subprized to: sign, verily and life all the principal's federal, state and local income, gift, estate, property and other tax (etc. as, including joint returns and declarations of estimated tax, pay all taxes; claim, sue for and receive all tax reluxed; examine and copy all the principal's tax returns and records; represent the principal belors any lederal, state or local revenue agency or taxing body and sign and deliver all tax powers of altomey on behalf of the principal that may be recessary for such purposes; waive rights and sign all documents on behalf of the principal as required to settle, buy and determine all tax liabilities; and, in general, exercise all powers
