Ween the title of any of the following categories is 'er ined (not struck out) in a statutory property power form, the effect will be to great the agent all of the principal's rights, powers an I discretions with respect to the types of property and transactions covered by the needhod emegory, subject to any immentions on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form.
