AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL SERVICE AREA SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NO. 24 BUCKINGHAM WOODS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois (the "Constitution"), the Village of Streamwood, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village"), is authorized to create special service areas in and for the Village; and

WHEREAS, home rule municipalities are authorized to establish special service areas pursuant to Section 6(1)(2) of Article VII of the Constitution, which provides the following:

"The General Assembly may not deny or limit the power of home rule units ..(2) to levy or impose additional taxes upon areas within their boundaries in the manner provided by law for the provision of special services to those areas and for the payment of debt incurred in order to provide those special services"; and

whereas, the home rule municipalities are further authorized to establish special service areas pursuant to the provisions of the "Special Service Area Tax Law," as amended, 35 lLCS 200/27-5 et seq (1994) (the "Law"), and pursuant to the Revenue Act of 1939 of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Streamwood is a home rule
municipality; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of a majority of the corporate authorities of the Village of Streamwood, it is advisable,

Said notice was given by depositing said notice in the United States Mail not less than ten (10) days prior to the time set for public hearing. A Certificate of Publication of said notice and Receipts of Mailing of said notice are attached to this Ordinance as Exhibits 1 and 2. Said notices conform in all respects to the requirements of Sections 27-25 and 27-30 of the aforesaid Law.

- B. That a public hearing on the questions set forth in the notice was held on December 2, 2004. All interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on the questions of the creation of the storm and curface water retention pond, detention basin and wetlands, and on the questions of an annual tax for maintenance of said storm and surface water retention pond, detention basin and wetlands as set forth in the notice. The public hearing was adjourned at 6:41 p.m. on December 2, 2004.
- C. The 60-day objection period provided for in Section 27-55 of the aforesaid Law has expired. No petitions were filed in opposition to the establishment of Special Service Area No. 24.
- D. That after considering the data, as presented at the public hearing, the Village finds that it is in the public interest and in the interest of the Village of Streamwood that Special Service Area No. 24, as hereinafter described, he established.
- E. Said area is compact and contiguous and constitutes a unique residential area of the Village of Streamwood.
- F. It is in the best interests of said Special Service
 Area that the furnishing of the municipal services proposed be

necessary and in the public interest that the Village of Streamwood consider the creation of a special service area in the area hereinafter described for the purpose of providing maintenance for storm and surface water retention pond, detention basin and wetlands.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Streamwood, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: FINDINGS OF THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES

The corporate authorities of the Village of Streamwood find as follows:

The question of the establishment of the Area Α. hereinafter described as a Special Service Area is considered by the President and Board of Trustees pursuant to an Ordinance entitled, "An Ordinance Proposing Establishment Of A Special Service Area No. 24 (Buckingham Woods) in the Village of Streamwood, Cook County, Illinois, and Providing For A Public Hearing and Other Procedures In Connection Therewith", (2004-52) adopted November 4, 2004, and is considered pursuant to a Hearing held on December 2, 2004, by the President and Board of Trustees pursuant to notice duly published in the Daily Herald of Paddock Publications, having general circulation within the Village of Streamwood on November 15, 2004, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Hearing, and pursuant to notice by mail addressed to the person or persons or trustee in whose name the general taxes for the last preceding year were paid on each lot, block, tract, or parcel of land lying within the proposed special service area.

considered for the common interests and the safety and welfare of the residents of said area.

G. Said area is zoned for residential purposes and will benefit specially from municipal services proposed to be provided. The proposed municipal services are unique and in addition to the municipal services provided to the Village of Streamwood as a whole.

SECTION TWO: THE VILLAGE OF STREAMWOOD SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NO. 24 ESTIBLISHED

A Special Service Area to be known and designated as "Village of Streamwood Special Service Area No. 24" is hereby established and shall consist of the following described territory:

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

THAT PART OF SECTION 21 AND 28 IN TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 9 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT THE 3 INCH REBAR IN CONCRETE MARKING THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF W.E. SECTION THREE: ZURPOSE OF AREA

village of Streamwood Special Service Area No. 24 is established to provide special municipal services to said area in addition to services provided to the Village generally. The purpose of the formation of the Village of Streamwood Special Service Area No. 24 in general is to provide special municipal services to the Area, including, but not limited to municipal services in connection with the maintenance, repair and replacement of (1) storm and surface water retertion pond and basin, as well as any and all feeders, laterals, storm drains and mains appurtenant; (2) the maintenance and care of such lands upon and surrounding such pond and basin and such ponds, basins and wetlands which provide benefits to the special service area proposed; (3) care and maintenance of wetland areas; (4) care and maintenance of the wooded areas and the path system in the woods; and (5) such administrative costs incurred by the Village in

connection with the above service, including, but not limited to, insurance premiums for liability insurance coverage.

In addition, annual taxes may be levied for the special services enumerated herein, on property in said Special Service Area No. 24, for said Special Service Area, in addition to all other Village taxes; provided, that the special annual taxes shall be limited so that the total of said tax does not exceed an amount of \$0.40 per \$100.00 of the assessed value, as equalized, to be levied against the property included in Special Service Area No. 24.

SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days following its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

The primary purpose of the formation of the Village of Streamwood Special Service Area No. 24 is to provide special municipal services to the Area, including, but not limited to municipal services in connection with the maintenance, repair and replacement of (1) storm and surface water retention pond and basin, as well as any and all feeders, laterals, storm drains and mains appurtenant; (2) the maintenance and care of such lands upon and surrounding such pond and basin and such ponds, basins and wetlands which provide benefits to the special service area proposed; (3) care and maintenance of wetland areas; (4) care and maintenance of the wooded areas and the path system in the woods; and (5) such administrative costs incurred by the Village in connection with the above service, including, but not limited to, insurance premiums for liability insurance coverage.

A special tax will be considered at the public hearing to be levied for an indefinite period and not exceed \$0.40 per \$100.00 of assessed value, as equalized, to be levied against the real property included in the Special Service Area.

At the hearing, all interested persons affected by the formation of such Special Service Area, including all persons owning taxable real estate therein, will be given an opportunity

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to be heard. The hearing may be adjourned by the Village Board to another date without further notice other than a motion to be entered upon the minutes of its meeting fixing the time and place of its adjournment.

If a petition signed by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the electors residing within the Special Service Area and by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the owners of record of the land included within the boundaries of the Special Service Area is filed with the Village Clerk within sixty (60) days following the final adjournment of the public hearing objecting to the creation of the Special Services District, the enlargement thereof, the levy or imposition of a tax or the issuance of bonds for the provision of such special services to the Area, or to a proposed increase in the tax rate, no such district may be created or enlarged, or tax may be levied or imposed nor the rate increased.
