

### ARTICLE FOUR

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To buy, sell and deal in cement of all kinds, lime, limestone, plaster and natural and artificial stone, and to erect, or buy, lease or otherwise acquire manufactories, kilns, and buildings; to build, maintain and operate manufactories, kilns, warehouses and depots for manufacturing and storing, buying, selling, dealing, pouring and installing cement and other products, and to transport, or cause to be transported the same, and to do any and all things incidental thereto and necessary and proper to be done in connection with the matters and things aforesaid on any of them.
