ANDERSON and ANTHONY PINTOZZI, JR. on behalf of the PAINTERS' DISTRICT COUNCIL NO. 30 HEALTH AND WELFARE FUND, the PAINTERS DISTRICT COUNCIL NO. 30 PENSION FUND, the NORTHERN ILLINOIS PAINTERS & DECORATORS JOINT APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING FUND; and the NORTHERN ILLINOIS PAINTING AND DRYWALL INSTITUTE and against Defendants Bassilios a/k/a "Bill" and a/k/a "William" Mataragas, d/b/a Superior Painting Contractors and d/b/a Superior Commercial & Industrial Painting, Inc., and Superior Commercial & Industrial Painting, Inc., JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY, in the total amount of \$50,975.81. This amount consists of: (a) \$19,966.09 in delinquent contributions for the period of January 1, 1998 through August 28, 2001; (b)


\$13,623.86 in interest through December 17, 2003; (c) \$13,623.86 in additional interest, as allowed under ERISA § 502(g)(2)(C)(i); and (d) \$3,762.00 in attorneys' fees and costs.

3. That a judgment is ordered to be entered in favor of Plaintiff DISTRICT COUNCIL NO. 30 OF THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF PAINTERS AND ALLIED TRADES, AFL-CIO, and against Defendants Bassilios a/k/a "Bill" and a/k/a "William" Mataragas, d/b/a Superior Painting Contractors and d/b/a Superior Commercial & Industrial Painting, Inc., and Superior Commercial & Industrial Painting, Inc., JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY, in the total amount of \$1,893.74. This amount consists of \$1,459.57 in union dues, \$302.67 in defense fund assessments, and \$131.50 in contributions for the Painters & Allied Trades Labor Management Cooperative Initiative for the International Brotherhood of Painters & Allied Trades Labor Management Fund, for the period of January 1, 1998 through August 28, 2001.

4. That Plaintiffs are awarded execution for the collection of the judgment and costs granted.

5. That the Court retains jurisdiction of this cause to enforce this Order.
