ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND LEASES

This ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND LEASES dated as of April 19, 2005 (the "Assignment"), is executed by 400 NORTH LASALLE STREET LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Assignor"), to and for the benefit of LASALLE BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION, a national banking association, its successors and assigns (the "Assignee").

RECITALS

- A. Pursuant to the terms of a Loan Agreement of even date herewith (as amended, modified, replaced or restated from time to time, the "Loan Agreement"), the Assignee has agreed to loan to the Assignor the original principal amount of Ninety Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$97,500,000.00) (the "Loan"), as evidenced by that certain Promissory Note dated even date herewith (as the same may be amended, modified, replaced or restated from time to time, the "Note"), executed by the Assignor and made payable to the order of the Assignee.
- B. A condition precedent to the Assignee's making of the Loan to the Assignor is the execution and delivery by the Assignor of this Assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

AGREEMENTS:

1. <u>Definitions</u>. All capitalized terms which are not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed thereto in that certain Mortgage, Security Agreement, Assignment of Rents and Leases And Fixture Filing dated as of even date herewith, executed by the Assignor to and for the benefit of the Assignee (the "<u>Mortgage</u>").

- Grant of Security Interest. The Assignor hereby absolutely and unconditionally grants, transfers, sets over and assigns to the Assignee, all of the right, title and interest of the Assignor in and to (i) all of the rents, revenues, issues, profits, proceeds, receipts, income, accounts and other receivables arising out of or from the land legally described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof and all buildings and other improvements located thereon (said land and improvements being hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Premises"), including, without limitation, lease termination fees, purchase option fees and other fees and expenses payable under any lease; (ii) all leases and subleases (each, a "Lease", and collectively, the "Leases"), now or hereafter existing, of all or any part of the Premises together with all guaranties of any of such Leases and all security deposits delivered by tenants thereunder, whether in cash or letter of credit; (iii) all rights and claims for damage against tenants arising out of defaults under the Leases, including rights to termination fees and compensation with respect to rejected Leases pursuant to Section 365(a) of the Federal Bankruptcy Code or any replacement Section thereof; and (iv) all tenant improvements and fixtures located on the Premises. This Assignment is an absolute transfer, subject to Section 5 below, and assignment of the foregoing interests to the Assignee given to secure:
 - (a) the payment by the Assignor when due of (i) the indebtedness evidenced by the Note and any and all renewals, extensions, replacements, amendments, modifications and refinancing; thereof; (ii) any and all other indebtedness and obligations that may be due and owing to the Assignee by the Assignor under or with respect to the Loan Documents (as defined in the Note); and (iii) all costs and expenses paid or incurred by the Assignee in enforcing its rights I ereunder, including without limitation, court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees; and
 - (b) the observance and performance by the Assignor of the covenants, conditions, agreements, representations, warranties and other liabilities and obligations of the Assignor or any other obligor to or benefiting the Assigner which are evidenced or secured by or otherwise provided in the Note, this Assignar and or any of the other Loan Documents, together with all amendments and modifications in recof.
- 3. <u>Representations and Warranties of the Assignor</u>. The Assignor represents and warrants to the Assignee that:
 - (a) this Assignment, as executed by the Assignor, constitutes the legal and binding obligation of the Assignor enforceable in accordance with its terms and provisions;
 - (b) the Assignor is the lessor under all Leases;
 - (c) except for that certain Junior Assignment of Rents and Leases (the "Junior Assignment") of even date herewith in favor of Lender to secure the Mezzanine Loan and the assignment of rents in favor of North LaSalle Funding to secure the North LaSalle Funding Loan (as such terms are defined in the Loan Agreement) to Assignor in the amount of \$17,350,000.00, there is no other existing assignment of the Assignor's entire or any part of its interest in or to any of the Leases, or any of the rents, issues, income or profits assigned hereunder, nor has the Assignor entered into any agreement to

subordinate any of the Leases or the Assignor's right to receive any of the rents, issues, income or profits assigned hereunder;

- (d) the Assignor has not executed any instrument or performed any act which may prevent the Assignee from operating under any of the terms and provisions hereof or which would limit the Assignee in such operation; and
- (e) to Assignor's knowledge (except as set forth in the rent roll delivered to Assignee on or before the date hereof), there are no defaults by the landlord and there are no material defaults by tenants under any Leases.
- 4. <u>Covenants of the Assignor</u>. The Assignor covenants and agrees that so long as this Assignment shall be in effect:
 - (a) the Assignor shall not lease any portion of the Premises unless the Assignor obtains are Assignee's prior written consent to all aspects of such lease unless the rents payable under the new lease shall be market rate rents as determined in good faith by Assignor
 - (b) the Assignor shall observe and perform all of the material covenants, terms, conditions and agreement contained in the Leases to be observed or performed by the lessor thereunder, and the Assignor shall not do or suffer to be done anything to impair the security thereof. The Assignor shall not (i) consent to any tenant's claim of a total or partial eviction, or (ii) enter into any oral leases with respect to all or any portion of the Premises;
 - (c) the Assignor shall not collect any of the rents, issues, income or profits assigned hereunder more than thirty days in advance of the time when the same shall become due, except for security or similar deposits or any lease termination payments;
 - (d) Other than the Junior Assignment, the Assignor shall not make any other assignment of its entire or any part of its interest in or to any or all Cases, or any or all rents, issues, income or profits assigned hereunder, and as otherwise specifically permitted by the Loan Documents;
 - (e) Assignor shall not modify the terms and provisions of any Lease if such modification would create a below market rent or cancel or terminate any Lease, without Assignee's prior written consent; provided, however, that Assignor may cancel or terminate any Lease as a result of a material default by the tenant thereunder and failure of such tenant to cure the default within the applicable time periods set forth in the Lease or otherwise in the ordinary course of business or in connection with the conversion of the Premises to a condominium in accordance with applicable law;
 - (f) Assignor shall not accept a surrender of any Lease or convey or transfer, or suffer or permit a conveyance or transfer, of the premises demised under any Lease or of any interest in any Lease so as to effect, directly or indirectly, proximately or remotely, a merger of the estates and rights of, or a termination or diminution of the obligations of, any tenant thereunder except in connection with the conversion of the Premises to a

condominium in accordance with applicable law; any termination fees payable under a Lease for the early termination or surrender thereof shall be treated as if such payment were a rent payment;

- (g) Assignor shall not alter, modify or change the terms of any guaranty of any Lease, or cancel or terminate any such guaranty or do or permit to be done anything which would terminate any such guaranty as a matter of law, except in the ordinary course of business;
- (h) Assignor shall not waive or excuse the obligation to pay rent under any Lease, except in the ordinary course of business;
- (i) the Assignor shall, at its sole cost and expense, appear in and defend any and all actions and proceedings arising under, relating to or in any manner connected with any Lease or the obligations, duties or liabilities of the lessor or any tenant or guarantor thereunder, and shall pay all costs and expenses of the Assignee, including court costs and reasonable attorneys' fees, in any such action or proceeding in which the Assignee may appear;
- (j) the Assignor shall give prompt notice to the Assignee of any notice of any default by the lessor under any commercial Lease received from any tenant or guarantor thereunder;
- (k) Assignor shall enforce the coservance and performance of each material covenant, term, condition and agreement contained in each Lease to be observed and performed by the tenants and guarantors thereunder and shall promptly notify Assignee of any material breach by the tenant or guarantor under any commercial Lease;
- (l) the Assignor shall not permit any of the Leases to become subordinate to any lien or liens other than liens securing the indebtedness recured hereby and liens for general real estate taxes or condominium assessments not delinquent;
- (m) Not later than forty-five (45) days after the end of each calendar quarter, Assignor shall deliver to Assignee a certified rent roll for the Premises as of the last day of such period in a form reasonably satisfactory to Assignee; and
- (n) Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, Assignor shall only enter into Leases so long as such leases are consistent with the Business Plan (as defined in the Loan Agreement).
- 5. Rights Prior to Default. Unless or until an Event of Default (as defined in Section 6) shall occur, the Assignor shall have the right to collect, at the time (but in no event more than thirty days in advance unless otherwise permitted herein) provided for the payment thereof, all rents, issues, income and profits assigned hereunder, and to retain, use and enjoy the same and exercise all rights of the landlord under the Leases except as otherwise provided herein. Upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, the Assignor's right to collect such rents, issues, income and profits shall immediately terminate without further notice thereof to the Assignor. The

Assignee shall have the right to notify the tenants under the Leases of the existence of this Assignment at any time.

- the occurrence of (a) Assignor fails to perform or cause to be performed any other obligation or observe any other condition, covenant, term, agreement or provision required to be performed or observed by Assignor under this Assignment; provided, however, that if such failure by its nature can be cured, then so long as the continued operation and safety of the Premises, and the priority, validity and enforceability of the liens created by the Deed of Trust or any of the other Loan Documents and the value of the Premises are not materially impaired, threatened or jeopardized, then Assignon shall have a period ("Cure Period") of thirty (30) days after Assignor receives written notice of such failure to cure the same and an Event of Default shall not be deemed to exist during the Cure Period, provided further that if Assignor commences to cure such failure during the Cure Period and is diligently and in good faith attempting to effect such cure, the Cure Period shall be extended for sixty (60) additional days, but in no event shall the Cure Period be longer than ninety (90) days in the aggregate or (b) any other Event of Default described in the Note, Deed of Trust or the other Loan Documents.
- 7. Rights and Remedies Upon Default. At any time upon or following the occurrence of any Event of Default, the Assignee, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies without any obligation to do so, without in any way waiving such Event of Default, without further notice or demand on the Assignor, without regard to the adequacy of the security for the obligations secured hereby, without releasing the Assignor or any guarantor of the Note from any obligation, and with or without bringing any action or proceeding to foreclose the Mortgage or any other lies or security interest granted by the Loan Documents:
 - (a) Declare the unpaid balance of the principal sum of the Note, together with all accrued and unpaid interest thereon, immediately due and payable;
 - (b) Enter upon and take possession of the Premises, either in person or by agent or by a receiver appointed by a court, and have, hold, manage, lease and operate the same on such terms and for such period of time as the Assignee may ceen necessary or proper, with full power to make from time to time all alterations, renovations repairs or replacements thereto or thereof as may seem proper to the Assignee, to make, enforce, modify and accept the surrender of Leases, to obtain and evict tenants, to fix or modify rents, and to do any other act which the Assignee deems necessary or proper;
 - (c) Either with or without taking possession of the Premises, demand, sue for, settle, compromise, collect, and give acquittances for all rents, issues, income and profits of and from the Premises and pursue all remedies for enforcement of the Leases and all the lessor's rights therein and thereunder. This Assignment shall constitute an authorization and direction to the tenants under the Leases to pay all rents and other amounts payable under the Leases to the Assignee, without proof of default hereunder, upon receipt from the Assignee of written notice to thereafter pay all such rents and other amounts to the Assignee and to comply with any notice or demand by the Assignee for observance or performance of any of the covenants, terms, conditions and agreements

contained in the Leases to be observed or performed by the tenants thereunder, and the Assignor shall facilitate in all reasonable ways the Assignee's collection of such rents, issues, income and profits, and upon request will execute written notices to the tenants under the Leases to thereafter pay all such rents and other amounts to the Assignee; and

- (d) Make any payment or do any act required herein of the Assignor in such manner and to such extent as the Assignee may deem necessary, and any amount so paid by the Assignee shall become immediately due and payable by the Assignor with interest thereon until paid at the Default Rate and shall be secured by this Assignment.
- 8. Application of Proceeds. All sums collected and received by the Assignee out of the rents, issues, income and profits of the Premises following the occurrence of any one or more Events of Default shall be applied in accordance with the Illinois Mortgage Foreclosure Law (Chapter 735, Sections 5/15-1101 et seq., Illinois Compiled Statutes) and, unless otherwise specified in such act, in such order as the Assignee shall elect in its sole and absolute discretion.
- Limitation of the Assignee's Liability. The Assignee shall not be liable for any loss sustained by the Assigner resulting from the Assignee's failure to let the Premises or from any other act or omission of the Assignee in managing, operating or maintaining the Premises following the occurrence of an Event of Default unless such loss is caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Assignee. The Assignee shall not be obligated to observe, perform or discharge, nor does the Assigner nereby undertake to observe, perform or discharge any covenant, term, condition or agreement contained in any Lease to be observed or performed by the lessor thereunder, or any obligation, duty or liability of the Assignor under or by reason of this Assignment. The Assignor shall and does herely agree to indemnify, defend (using counsel reasonably satisfactory to the Assignee) and hold the Assignee harmless from and against any and all liability, loss or damage which the Assignee may ir cur under any Lease or under or by reason of this Assignment and of and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against the Assignee by reason of any alleged obligation or undertaking on its part to observe or perform any of the covenants, terms, conditions and agreements contained in any Lease; provided, however, in no event shall the Assignor be liable for any liability, loss or damage which the Assignor incurs as a result of the Assignee's gross negligence or willful misconduct. Should the Assignee incur any such liability, loss or damage under any Lease or under or by reason of this Assignment, or in the defense of any such claim or demand, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses and reasonable attorneys' fees, shall become immediately due and payable by the Assignor with interest thereon at the Default Rate and shall be secured by this Assignment. This Assignment shall not operate to place responsibility upon the Assignee for the care, control, management or repair of the Premises or for the carrying out of any of the covenants, terms, conditions and agreements contained in any Lease, nor shall it operate to make the Assignee responsible or liable for any waste committed upon the Premises by any tenant, occupant or other party, or for any dangerous or defective condition of the Premises, or for any negligence in the management, upkeep, repair or control of the Premises resulting in loss or injury or death to any tenant, occupant, licensee, employee or stranger. Nothing set forth herein or in the Mortgage, and no exercise by the Assignee of any of the rights set forth herein or in the Mortgage shall constitute or be construed as constituting the Assignee a "mortgagee in possession" of the Premises, in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the Premises by the Assignee pursuant to the provisions hereof or of the Mortgage.
