

THIS CONDOMINIUM RIDER is made this 2nd day of March, 2006, and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust, or Security Deed ("Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned ("Borrower") to secure Borrower's Home Equity Line of Credit Agreement and Disclosure Statement ("HELOC") entered into with GMAC BANK ("Lender") of the same date and covering the Property described in the Security Instrument and located

The Property recides a unit in, together with an undivided interest in the common elements of, a condominium progra known as:

("Condominium Project"). If the owners association or other entity which acts for the Condominium Project ("Owners Association") holds title to property for the benefit or use of its members or shareholders, the Property also includes Borrower's interest in the Owners Association and the uses, proceeds and benefits of Borrower', incerest.

Such proceeds shall be applied by Lender to the sums secured by the Security Instrument as provided in Section 6.

E. Lender's Prior Consent. F. Ponedies. If Borrower does not pay condominium dues and assessments when due, then Lender may pay them. Any amounts disbursed by Lender under this paragraph F shall become additional indebtedness of Borrower secured by the Security Instrument. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment these amounts shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the HELOC rate and shall be prevatle, with interest, upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment.


