  - Lender waives the provision in Uniform Covenant 2 for the monthly payment to Lender of one-(i) twelfth of the yearly premium installments for hazard insurance on the Property; and

  - (iii) termination of professional management and assumption of self-management of the Owners Association; or
  - (iv) any action which would have the effect of rendering the public liability insurance coverage maintained by the Owners Association unacceptable to Lender.
