WFMORANDUM OF LEASE

Superior Street, Chicago, IL 60611, (the "Landlord") and CHICAGO JESUIT ACADEMY, an Illinois non-for-profit corporation, having an address c/o 2050 N. Clark Street, Chicago, IL 60614 (the "Tenant").

WITNESSETH.

1. **Basic Terms.** Landlord and Tenant are the currer landlord and tenant of that certain Lease dated as of February 23, 2007 (the "Lease"), and Landlord hereby leases to Tenant, according to the terms of the Lease, the Premises (as defined in the Lease), which Premises are more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.
