JUDGMENT FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard upon a Petition for Dissolution of Marriage; the Petitioner having appeared in person along with the Petitioner's attorney, JOHN G. MASTERLY; the Respondent having filed an appearance pro se; a Stipulation and Request to Hear Uncontested Cause having been filed; the Court, having heard the testimony on behalf of the Petitioner in support of his Petition for Dissolution of Marriage, and being fully advised in the premises, FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter herein and of the parties hereto.
2. That the Petitioner was a resident of the State of Illinois at the time the Petition was filed and has maintained residency in the State of Illinois for more than ninety days preceding the making of these findings.
3. That the parties were married on February 15, 1969 in Chicago, Illinois,

and the marriage was registered in Cook County, Illinois.

4. That the parties separated on or about November 23, 2003 and have lived separately and apart without interruption since that date.
5. That there were two children born of the marriage, namely, GEORGE R. GUERRERO, now 35 years old, and RUBEN R. GUERRERO, JR., now 28 years old. No children were adopted and the Respondent is not now pregnant.
6. That the grounds of irreconcilable differences has been established in that all attempts to reconcile have failed and both parties consider the marriage in fact dead.

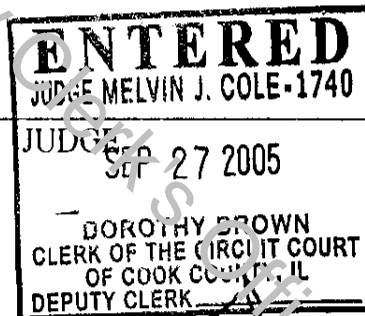
WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage is hereby entered instanter in favor of the parties and the bonds of matrimony existing the parties are hereby dissolved.
2. That the Respondent is hereby granted leave to resume her maiden name of ALLEN.
3. That both parties are hereby awarded their own respective personal property with Respondent to have a period of six months from the date of dissolution to remove all of her personal belongings from the marital residence located at 1035 W. 34th Place, Chicago, IL 60608. That the Respondent is hereby awarded the 1998 Ford Taurus now in her possession and the Petitioner shall convey sole title to

Respondent for said vehicle after all payments are made by him for said vehicle. That the Respondent convey to the Petitioner sole title to the 1997 Pontiac Grand Am.

4. That both parties are hereby barred from maintenance now and forevermore.
5. That each party shall be solely responsible for their own debts from the date of January 1, 2000.
6. That all other issues – including the disposition of the marital home located at 1035 W. 34th Place, Chicago, IL 60608 – are hereby reserved.
7. That the Court expressly retains jurisdiction of this Judgment for the purpose of enforcing all of the terms of this Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.
