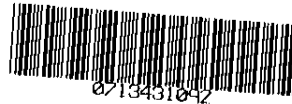

THE UNDERSIGNED LIEN CLAIMANT, Standard Lumber Co., ("Claimant" herein) an Illinois corporation, whose principal office is located at 1912 Lehigh, Glenview, Illinois, hereby records a claim for Mechanic's Lien against Ross Builders and Developers, Inc. of 3105 N. Ashland Avenue, #343, Chicago, IL (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"); Prairie Park Development Corporation of 833 Elm Street, Suite 205, Wilmette, IL (hereinafter referred to as "Owner"); North Shore Community Bank and Trust of 1145 Wilmette Avenue, Wilmette, IL (herein referred to as "Lender") and all other persons or entities having or claiming an interest in the below described real estate, and in support thereof states as follows

1. On or about October 21, 2006, Owner owned the following described real estate in the County of Cook, State of Illinois, to wit:

Lot 3 in Block 21 in North Evanston, a subdivision of the South part of Wilmette Reserve in Township 42 North, Range 13, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

Commonly known as 2642 N. Prairie, Evanston, Cook County, Illinois, which real estate has the following permanent index number: 05-34-422-006 and which is hereinafter together with all improvements referred to as the "premises."

2. On a date unknown to Lien Claimant, Owner, or one knowingly permitted by the Owner to do so entered into a contract with Contractor wherein Contractor was to provide labor, materials and equipment for the construction of a building, alterations and improvements to and for the benefit of the premises.

3. October 21, 2006, Contractor made a written subcontract with Lien Claimant to furnish and supply lumber and building material to the premises on an open credit agreement. From time to time thereafter Contractor ordered lumber and building material from Lien Claimant having a value of in the amount of \$55,610.06 for said improvement.

4. On March 29, 2007, Lien Claimant substantially completed delivery of materials to the value of \$55,610.06.
