Section 3-4. Explanation of powers granted in the statutory short from power of attorney for property. This Section defines each category of powers listed in the statetory short form power of attorney for correcty and the effect of granting powers to an agent. When the title of any of the following entegories is remined (not struck out) in a sortatory property power form, the effect will be to grant the agent all of the principal's rights, powers and discretions with respect to the type, of property and transactions covered by the retained category, subject to any limitations on the granted powers that appear on the face of the form. The agent will have authority to exercise each granted power for and in the name of the principal with respect to all of the principal's interest in every type of property or transaction covered by the granted power at the time of morcine, whether the principal's interests are direct or indirect, whole or fractional, legal, equitable or contracted, as a joint tenant or tenant in common or held in ever ther form; but the agent will not have power under any of the statutory estagaries (a) through (o) to make gifts of the principal's property to eversise powers to appoint to others or to change any beneficiary whom the principal has designated to take the principal's into sove at death under any will, trust, joint tenancy, beneficiary form or contractual arrangement. The agent will be under no duty to exercise granted powers or to assume control of or responsibility for the principal's property or affairs; but when granted powers are exercises, the cent will be required to use due care to act for the benefit of the principal in accordance with the terms of the statutory property | ower and will be liable for negligent exercise. The agent may act in person or through others reasonably employed by the agent for that parameter and will have authority to sign and deliver all instruments, negotiate and enter into all agreements and do all other acts recoverably necessary to implement the exercise of the powers granted to the agent.

- (a) Real estate transactions. - (b) Financial institutions transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, close, continue and control all accounts and deposits in any type of financial institution (which term includes, without limitation, banks, trust companies, savings and building and loan associations, credit unions, brokerage firms); deposit in and withdraw from and write checks on any financial institution account or deposit, and, in general, coercise all powers with respect to financial institution transactions which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Stock and bond transactions. The agent is sutherized to: buy and sell all types of securities (which term includes, without limitation, stocks, bonds, mutual funds and all other types of investment securities and financial instruments); collect, hold and safekeep all dividends, interest, earnings, proceeds of sale, distributions, theres, certificates and other evidences of ownership paid or distributed with respect to securities; exercise all voting rights with respect to securities in person or by proxy, enter into voting traits and consent to limitations on the rights to vote, and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to securities which the principal could if present and under no disability to tangible personal property which the principal could if present and under no disability.

- (d) Tangible personal property transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy and sell, lease, exchange, collect, possess and take title to all tangible personal property; move, store, ship, restore, maintain, repair, improve, manage, preserve, insure and safekeep tangible personal property; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to tangible personal property which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (c) Safe deposit box transactions. The agent is authorized to: open, continue and have access to all safe deposit boxes; sign, renew, release or terminate any safe deposit contract, drill or surrender any safe deposit box, and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to safe deposit matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (f) Insurance and annuity transactions. The agent is authorized to: procure, acquire, continue, renew, terminate or otherwise deal with any type of insurance or annuity contract (which terms include, without limitation, life, accident, health, disability, automobile casualty, property or liability insurance); pay premiums or assessments on or surrender and collect all distributions, proceeds or benefits payable under any ir an once or annuity contract, and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to insurance and annuity contracts which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (g) Retirement plan transitions. The agent is authorized to: contribute to, withdraw from and deposit funds in any type of retirement plan (which text includes, without limitation, any tax qualified or non-qualified pension, profit sharing, stock bonus, employee savings and other retirement plan, individual retirement account, deferred compensation plan and any other type of employee benefit plan); select and change payment options for the principal under any retirement plan; make rollower contributions from any retirement plan to other retirement plan or individual retirement accounts; exercise all investment powers available under any type of self-directed retirement plan; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to retirement plans and retirement plan account balances which the principal could if present and under an disability.
- (h) Social Security, unemployment and military service benefits. The agent is authorized to: prepare, sign and file any claim or application for Social Security, unemployment or military service benefits; sue for, settle or abandon any claims to any benefit or assistance under any federal, state, local or foreign statue of rejustion; control, deposit to any account, collect, receipt for, and take title to and hold all benefits under any Social Security, unemployment, military service or other state, federal, local or foreign statue or regulation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to Social Security, unemployment, military service and governmental benefits which the principal could if present and under no disability
- (i) Tax metters. The agent is authorized to: sign, verify and file at the principal's federal, state and local income, gift, estate, property and other tax returns, including joint returns and declarations of examined tax; pay all taxes, claim, sue for and receive all tax refunds; commine and copy all the principal's tax returns and receively, represent the principal before any federal, state or local revenue agency or toxing body and sign and deliver all tax powers of attorney on behalf of the principal as required to settle, pay and obtaining all tax liabilities; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to tax matters which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (j) Claims and litigation. The agent is authorized to: institute, prosecute, defend, above, compromise, arbitrate, settle and dispose of any claim in favor of or against the principal or any property interests of the principal; claim or settlement proceeds and waive or release all rights of the principal; employ attorneys and others and enter a contingency agreements and other contracts as necessary in connection with litigation; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to claims and litigation which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (k) Commedity and option transactions. The agent is authorized to: buy, sell, exchange, assign, convey, with and exercise commedities futures contracts and call and put options on stocks and stock indices traded on a regulated options on an ge and collect and receipt for all proceeds of any such transactions; establish or continue option accounts for the principal with any security or futures broker, and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to commedities and options which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (i) Business operations. The agent is authorized to: organize or continue and conduct my business (which term includes, without limitation, any farming, manufacturing, service, mining, retailing or other type of business operation) in any form, whether as a proprietorship, joint vesture, partnership, corporation, trust or other legal entity; operate, buy, sell, corporat, terminate or liquidate my business; direct, control, supervise, manage or participate in the operation of any business and engage, compensate and discharge business managers, employees, agents, attorneys, accountants and consultants; and, in general, exercise all powers with respect to business interests and operations which the principal could if present and under no disability.
- (m) Borrowing transactions.
