Based on the foregoing, the decedent left surviving as her only heirs at law, the following:



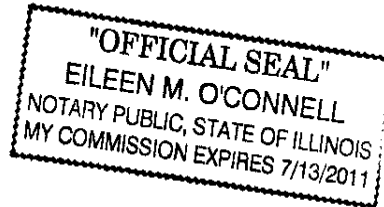
