There agreements are on terms and conditions that are satisfactory to the mortgage insurer and the other party (or parties) to these agreements. These agreements may require the mortgage insurer to make payments using ray source of funds that the mortgage insurer may have available (which may include funds obtained from Mortgage Insurance premiums).

As a result of these agreements, Lender, any purchaser of the Note, another insurer, any rei is er, any other entity, or any affiliate of any of the foregoing, may receive (directly or indirectly) amounts that der ve from (or might be characterized as) a portion of Borrower's payments for Mortgage Insurance, in exchange for sharing or modifying the mortgage insurer's risk, or reducing losses. If such agreement provides that an affiliate of Lender takes a share of the insurer's risk in exchange for a share of the pre niums paid to the insurer, the arrangement is often termed "captive reinsurance." Further:

(a) Any such agreements will not affect the amounts that Borrower has agreed to pay for Mcrtgage Insurance, or any other terms of the Loan. Such agreements will not increase the amount Borrower will owe for Mortgage Insurance, and they will not entitle Borrower to any refund.

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(b) Any such agreements will not affect the rights Borrower has - if any - with respect to the Mortgage Insurance under the Homeowners Protection Act of 1998 or any other law. These rights may include the right to receive certain disclosures, to request and obtain cancellation of the Mortgage Insurance, to have the Mortgage Insurance terminated automatically, and/or to receive a refund of any Mortgage Insurance premiums that were unearned at the time of such cancellation or ternination.

11. Assignment of Miscellaneous Proceeds; Forfeiture. All Miscellaneous Proceeds are hereby

assigned to and shall be paid to Lender.

If the Property is damaged, such Miscellaneous Proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property, if the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not lessened. Dur ng such repair and restoration period, Lender shall have the right to hold such Miscellaneous Proceeds unti Lenar has had an opportunity to inspect such Property to ensure the work has been completed to Len ler's constaction, provided that such inspection shall be undertaken promptly. Lender may pay for the repairs and restoration in a single disbursement or in a series of progress payments as the work is completed. Unless an agreement is made in writing or Applicable Law requires interest to be paid on such Miscellaneous I roceeds, Lender shall not be required to pay Borrower any interest or earnings on such Miscellaneous Proceeds. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the Miscolar cous Proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower. Such Miscellaneous Proceeds shall be app ied in the order provided for in Section 2.

In the event of a total taling, destruction, or loss in value of the Property, the Miscellaneous Proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with

the excess, if any, paid to Borrower.

In the event of a partial taking, destruction, or loss in value of the Property in which the fair market value of the Property immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value is equal to or greater than the amount of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall be reduced by the amount of the Miscellaneous Proceeds multiplied by the following fraction: (a) the total amount of the sums secured immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value divide by (b) the fair market value of the Property immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value. Any balance shall be paid to Borrower.

In the event of a partial taking, destruction, or loss in value of the Property in which the fair market value of the Property immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value is less than the amount of the sums secured immediately before the partial taking, destruction, or loss in value, unless Bor ower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, the Miscellaneous Proceeds shall be applied to the sums

secured by this Security Instrument whether or not the sums are then due

If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if, after notice by Lender to Borrower that the Opposing Party (as defined in the next sentence) offers to make an award to sail a claim for damages, Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days after the date the notice is givan, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the Miscellaneous Proceeds either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. "Opposing Party" means the third party that owes Borrower Miscellaneous Proceeds or the party against whom Borrower has a light of action in regard to Miscellaneous Proceeds.

Borrower shall be in default if any action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begur that, in Let der's judgment, could result in forfeiture of the Property or other material impairment of Let der's interest in the Property or rights under this Security Instrument. Borrower can cure such a default and if acceleration has occurred, reinstate as provided in Section 19, by causing the action or proceeding to be dismissed with a ruling that, in Lender's judgment, precludes forfeiture of the Property or other material impairment of Lender's interest in the Property or rights under this Security Instrument. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages that are attributable to the impairment of Lender's interest in the Property are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

All Miscellaneous Proceeds that are not applied to restoration or repair of the Property shall be

apr lied in the order provided for in Section 2.

12. Borrower Not Released; Forbearance By Lender Not a Waiver. Extension of the time for payment or modification of amortization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument granted by Lender

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to Borrower or any Successor in Interest of Borrower shall not operate to release the liability of Borrower or any Successors in Interest of Borrower. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against any Successor in Interest of Borrower or to refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amo tization of the sums secured by this Security Instrument by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower or any Successors in Interest of Borrower. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy including, without limitation, Lender's acceptance of payments from third persons, entities or Successors in Interest of Borrower or in amounts less than the amount then due, shall not be a waiver of or prec ude the exercise of any right or remedy.

13. Joint and Several Liability; Co-signers; Successors and Assigns Bound. Borrower covenants and agrees that Borrower's obligations and liability shall be joint and several. However, any Borrower who co-s gns this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note (a "co-signer"): (a) is co-signing this Security instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey the co-signer's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument, and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower can agree to extend, modify, forbear or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without the co-s gner's consent.

Subject to the provisions of Section 18, any Successor in Interest of Borrower who assumes Borrower's obligations vader this Security Instrument in writing, and is approved by Lender, shall obtain all cf Borrower's rights and benefits under this Security Instrument. Borrower shall not be released from Borrower's obligations and liability under this Security Instrument unless Lender agrees to such release in writ ng. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind (except as provided in Section 20) and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender.

14. Loan Charges. Lender may charge Borrower fees for services performed in connection with Borrower's default, for the purpose of projecting Lender's interest in the Property and rights under this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees, property inspection and valuation fees. In regard to any other fees, the absence of express authority in this Security Instrument to charge a specific fee to Borrower shall not be construed as a problibition on the charging of such fee. Lender may not charge fees that are expressly prohibited by this Security II strur lent or by Applicable Law.

If the Loan is subject to a law which sets maximum, loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be cliected in connection with the Loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limi's will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any pre-vayment charge (whether or not a pregayment charge is provided for under the Note). Borrower's acceptar se of any such refund made by direct payment to Borrower will constitute a waiver of any right of action Borrower might have arising out of such overcharge.

15. Notices. All notices given by Borrower or Lender in connection with this Security Instrument must be in writing. Any notice to Borrower in connection with this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower when mailed by first class mail or when actually delivered to Borrower's notice address if sent by other means. Notice to any one Borrower shall constitute notice to all Borrowers unless Applicable Law expressly requires otherwise. The notice address shall be the Property Address unless Borrower has designated a substitute notice address by notice to Lender. Borrower shall promptly notify Lender of Borrower's change of address. If Lender specifies a procedure for reporting Borrower's change of address, then Borrower shall only report a change of address through that specified procedure. The e may be only one designated notice address under this Security Instrument at any one time. Any notize to Lender shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein unless Lender has designated another address by notice to Borrower. Any notice in connection with this Security Instrument shall not be deemed to have been given to Lender until actually received by Lender. If any notice required by this Security Instrument is also required under Applicable Law, the Applicable Law requirement will satisfy the corresponding requirement under this Security Instrument.

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16. Governing Law; Severability; Rules of Construction. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. All rights and obligations contained in this Security Instrument are subject to any requirements and limitations of Applicable Law. Applicable Law might explicitly or implicitly allow the parties to agree by contract or it might be silent, but such silence shall not be construed as a prohibition against agreement by contract. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with Applicable Law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision.

As used in this Security Instrument: (a) words of the masculine gender shall mean and include corresponding neuter words or words of the feminine gender; (b) words in the singular shall mean and include the plural and vice versa; and (c) the word "may" gives sole discretion without any obligation to take any action.

17. 2 rrower's Copy. Borrower shall be given one copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

18. Transfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. As used in this Section 18, "Interest in the Property" means any legal or beneficial interest in the Property, including, but not limited to, those beneficial interests transferred in a bond for deed, contract for deed, installment sales contract or escribe agreement, the intent of which is the transfer of title by Borrower at a future date to a purchaser.

If all or any part of the Property or any Interest in the Property is sold or transferred (or if Borrower is not a natural person and a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by App icable Law.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given in accordance with Section 15 within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

- 19. Borrower's Right to Reinstate After Acceleration. If Borrower meets certain conditions, Borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of u is Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earliest of: (a) five days before sale of the Property pursuant to Section 22 of this Security Instrument; (b) such other period as Applicable Law might specify for the termination of Borrower's right to reinstate; or (c) entry of a judgment enforcing this Securit Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note as if no acceleration had occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees, property inspection and valuation fees, and other fees incurred for uncomprose of protecting Lender's interest in the Property and rights under this Security Instrument; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that Lender's interest in the Property and ricots under this Security Instrument, and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument, shall continue unchanged unless as otherwise provided under Applicable Law. Lender may require that Borrower pay such reinstatement sums and expenses in one or more of the following forms, as select d b Lender: (a) cash (b) money order; (c) certified check, bank check, treasurer's check or cashier's check, rovided any such check is drawn upon an institution whose deposits are insured by a federal agency, instrumentality or entity; or (d) Electronic Funds Transfer. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Institute it and obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as if no acceleration had occurred. However, his right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under Section 18.
- 20. Sale of Note; Change of Loan Servicer; Notice of Grievance. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) can be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. A sale might result in a change in the entity (known as the "Loan Servicer") that collects Periodic Payments due under the Note and this Security Instrument and performs other mortgage loan servicing obligations under the Note, this Security Instrument, and Applicable Law. There also might be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to a sale of the Note. If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, Borrower will be given written notice of the change which will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer, the address to which payments should be made and any other information RESPA

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requires in connection with a notice of transfer of servicing. If the Note is sold and thereafter the Loan is serv ced by a Loan Servicer other than the purchaser of the Note, the mortgage loan servicing obligations to Borrower will remain with the Loan Servicer or be transferred to a successor Loan Servicer and are not assu ned by the Note purchaser unless otherwise provided by the Note purchaser.

The notice of acceleration and opportunity to sure given to Borrower pursuant to Section 22 and the notice of acceleration given to Borrower pursuant to Section 18 shall be deemed to satisfy the notice and opportunity to take corrective action provisions of this Section 20.

21. Hazardous Substances. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property (a, that is in violation of any Environmental Law, (b) which creates an Environmental Condition, or (c) which, due to the presence, use, or release of a Hazardous Substance, creates a condition that adversely affects the value of the Property. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Frenetty of small quantities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to no medical uses and to maintenance of the Property (including, but not limited to, hazardous substances in concumer products).

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of (a) any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge (b) any Environmental Condition, including but not limited to, any spilling, leaking, discharge, release of time at of release of any Hazardous Substance, and (c) any condition caused by the presence, use or release of a Hazardous Substance which adversely affects the value of the Property. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, or any private party, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remedial actions in accordance with Environmental Law. Nothing herein shall create any obligation on Lender for an Environmental Cleanup.

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NON-UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

- 22. Acceleration; Remedies. Lender shall give notice to Borrower prior to acceleration following Borrower's breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument (but not prior to acceleration under Section 18 unless Applicable Law provides otherwise). The notice shall specify: (a) the default; (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date, not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given to Borrower, by which the default must be cured; and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Security Instrument, foreclosure by judicial proceeding and sale of the Property. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the foreclosure proceeding the non-existence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and foreclosure. If the default is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice, Lender at its opt on may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument without further demand and may foreclose this Security Instrument by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to effect all expenses incurred in pursuing the remedies provided in this Section 22, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of title evidence.
- 23. Release. Upon payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall release this Security Instrument. Borrower shall pay any recordation costs. Lender may charge Borrower a fee for releasing this Security Instrument, but only if the fee is paid to a third party for services rendered and the charging of the fee is permitted under Applicable Law.

24. Waiver of Homestead. In accordance with Illinois law, the Borrower hereby releases and waives all rights under and by virtue of the Illinois homestead exemption laws.

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ADJUSTABLE RATE RIDER (LIBOR One Year Index (As Published in *The Wall Street Journal*)

THIS ADJUSTABLE R ATE RIDER is made this 15th day of April, 2008, and is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust, or Security Deed (the "Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Adjustable Rate Note (the "Note") to Cartus Home Loans (fka Cendant Mortgage) (the "Lender") of the same date and covering the property described in the Scoulity Instrument and located at:

THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT. THE NOTE LIMITS THE AMOUNT THE BORROWER'S INTEREST RATE CAN CHANGE AT ANY ONE TIME AND THE MAXIMUM RATE THE BORROWER MUST PAY.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

A. ADJUSTABLE RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

Beginning with the Commencement Date (as that term is defined in the Note), the Note provides that Borrower will pay interest at an initial fixed rate equal to the margin described in the Note blus current Fixed Rate Index figure. The Fixed Rate Index is the Federal National Mortgage Associations equired net yield for 30-year fixed rate mortgages subject to a 60-day mandatory delivery computation, as put lished in *The Wall Street Journal*. The Note also provides for a change in the initial fixed interest rate to an adjustable interest rate, as follows:

4. INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

(A) Change Dates

The interest rate I will pay may change on the first day of May, 2014 and on that day every 12 months thereafter. Each date on which my interest rate could change is called a "Change Date."

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(B) The Index

Beginning with the first Change Date, my interest rate will be based on an Index. The "Index" is the average of interbank offered rates for one-year U.S. dollar-denominated deposits in the London market ("LIBOR"), as published in *The Wall Street Journal*. The most recent Index figure available as of 45 days before each Change Date occurs is called the "Current Index."

If ma index is no longer available, the Note Holder will choose a new index which is based upon comparable information. The Note Holder will give me notice of this choice.

(C) Calculation of Changes

Before each Charge Date, the Note Holder will calculate my new interest rate by adding Two and Two nty-Five / Hundrouth percentage points (2.250%) to the Current Index. The Note Holder will then round the result of this add tion to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). Subject to the limits stated in Section 4(D) below, this rounded amount will be my new interest rate until the next Change Date.

The Note Holder will then determine the amount of the monthly payment that would be sufficient to repay the unpaid Principal that I am expected to owe at the Change Date in full on the Maturity Date at my new interest in substantially equal payment. The result of this calculation will be the new amount of my monthly payment.

(D) Limits on the Interest Rate Changes

The interest rate I am required to pay at the first Clange Date will not be greater than the initial fixed interest rate plus Five percentage points (5.000%) class than 2.250%. Thereafter, my interest rate will never be increased or decreased on any single Change Date by more than Two percentage points (2.000%) from the rate of interest I have been paying for the proceding twelve months. My permanent interest rate, commencing on the first Change Date, will never be greater than my initial fixed interest rate plus Five percent (5.000%) which is called the "Maximum Kate."

(E) Effective Date of Changes

My new interest rate will become effective on each Change Date. I will pay the amount of my new monthly payment beginning on the first monthly payment date after the Change Date until the amount of my monthly payment changes again.

(F) Notice of Changes

The Note Holder will deliver or mail to me a notice of any changes in my interest rate and the and of ny monthly payment before the effective date of any change. The notice will include information required by law to be given to me and also the title and telephone number of a person who will answer any question I may have regarding the notice.

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B. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER

1. Until Borrower's initial fixed interest rate changes to an adjustable interest rate under the terms stated in Section A above, Uniform Covenant 18 of the Security Instrument shall read as follows:

Tr. nsfer of the Property or a Beneficial Interest in Borrower. As used in this Section 18, "Interest in the Property" means any legal or beneficial interest in the Property, including, but not limited to, those beneficial interests transferred in a bond for deed, contract for deed, installment sales contract or escrow agreement, the intent of which is the transfer of title by Borrower at a future date to a purchaser.

If all or any part of the Property or any Interest in the Property is sold or transferred (or if Borrower is not a natural person and a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred) without Lender's prior witten consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. When Borrower's initial fixed interest rate changes of an adjustable interest rate under the terms stated in Section A above, Uniform Covenant 18 of the Security Instrument described in Section B1 above shall then cease to be in effect, and the provisions of Uniform Coverant 18 of the Security Instrument shall be amended to read as follows:

As used in this Section 18, "Interest in the Property" means any legal or beneficial interest in the Property including, but not limited to, those beneficial interests transferred in a bond for deed, contract for deed, installment sales contract or escrow agreement, the intent of which is the transfer of title by Borrower at a future date to a purchaser.

If all or any part of the Property or any Interest in the Property is sold or transferred (or if Borrower is not a natural person and a beneficial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by Applicable Law. Lender also shall not exercise this option if: (a) Borrower causes to be submitted to Lender information required by Lender to evaluate the intended transferee as if a new loan were being made to the transferee; and (b) Lender reasonably determines that Lender's security will not be impaired by the loan assumption and that the risk of a breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument is acceptable to Lender.

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To the extent permitted by Applicable Law, Lender may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's consent to the loan assumption. Lender may also require the transferee to sign an assumption agreement that is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transferee to keep all the promises and agreements made in the Note and in this Security Instrument. Borrower will continue to be obligated under the Note and this Security Instrument unless Lender releases Borrower in writing.

If Lender exercises the option to require immediate payment in full, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. The notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is given in accordance with Section 15 within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If Borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

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CONSTRUCTION/PERMANENT LOAN RIDER

THIS CONSTRUCTION/PERMANENT LOAN RIDER, dated April 15, 2008, is incorporated into and shall be deemed to amend and supplement the Mortgage, Deed of Trust or Security Deed (the "Security Instrument") of the same date given by the undersigned (the "Borrower") to secure Borrower's Note (the "Note") to Cartus Home Loans (fka Cendant Mor.gag.) (the "Lender") of the same date.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS: In addition to the covenants and agreements made in the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

- I. Future Advances. The Security Instrument secures advances made, and future advances to be made, pursuar t to the terms of a Construction Loan Agreement be ween Borrower and Lender of the same date. A default under the terms of the Construction Loan Agreement and/or the Note shall also constitute a default under the terms of the Security Instrument.
- 2. Construction Interest Rate. During the period of construction as set forth in the Construction Loan Agreement and until the 04/30/2009 (the "Scheduled Termination Date"), ne interest rate may change on the first day of each month and shall be equal to the sum of 0% plus the highest prime rate published in *The Wall Street Journa*' as of the last business day of the preceding month (the "Prime Rate"), except as set forth in paragraph 3 below. During this period and until the permanent financing phase of the loan begins are interest rate will never be greater than 18%.
- 3. Commencement Date Change (if applicable). If the improvements described in th: Construction Loan Agreement are to be completed before or after 05/01/2009 (the "Commencement Date"), Lender may at its option, move the Commencement Date to a date which is earlier or later than the date defined as such in the Note, as more particularly set forth below:
- (a) <u>Interest Rate During Extended Construction Phase.</u> Borrower shall request an extension of the construction phase at least five days before the Commencement Date, but in no event earlier than sixty days before the Conmencement Date. If the Lender approves the extension of the term of the construction phase, the interest rate during the extension periods shall be calculated by adding **0**% to the Prime Rate, plus the Construction Extens on Margin of .2500%.

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Lender may evidence the extension of the construction phase by providing written notice of such extension to the Borrower. An extension of the term of the construction phase may result in an extension of the maturity date of the Security Instrument. With the exception of the interest rate, all the terms and conditions of this Rider shall continue to apply during any such extension and Borrower agrees to make payments, at the then applicable interest rate during such extended period(s).

- Rec. Protection

 If the Borrower has entered into a rate protection agreement, such rate protection expires on the day preceding the Commencement Date. If Borrower requests an extension of the term of the construction phase, within the time frame set forth in subparagraph (a) above, the Borrower has the option to cap the permanent interest rate or initial permanent interest rate, as applicable, for the duration of the extended construction loan period or allow the permanent interest rate or initial permanent interest rate, as applicable, to "float" until the permanent interest rate is established in accordance with the terms of the Note. If the Borrower does not elect to re-cap the interest rate, the Borrower's permanent interest rate may be higher than the original capped rate. In the event the Borrower elects to re-cap the interest rate, the new capped rate may be higher that the origina capped interest rate and/or the Borrower may have to pay points, depending on the then current market interest rate. In the event construction is not timely completed and the Borrower does not request an extension to the construction phase, the Borrower's interest rate will "float" until the permanent rate is established in accordance with the terms of the Note.
- (c) Extension of Construction Term In the vent the construction term is extended, Borrower agrees to execute any additional documentation which Lender may request to confirm the extension, the construction interest rate, the maturity date, the permanent interest rate cap or any other term of the Note. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Lender may unilaterally modify the dates and interest rate consistent with the terms of this Rider by sending notice to the Borrower and Borrower agrees to be bound by are modified dates and interest rate in making payments.
- 4. Permanent Interest Rate or Initial Permanent Interest Rate. The Note provides that when the permanent financing phase of the loan begins, Borrower will pay interest, for the remaining term of the loan or for an initial fixed rate period, at a fixed rate equal to the margin described in the Note plus the then current "Fixed Rate Index" figure. The Fixed Rate Index is the Federal National Mortgage Association's required net yield for 30-year fixed rate mortgages subject to a 60-day mandatory delivery commitment, as published in The Wall Street Journal. If either of the following rates is lower than the Fixed Rate Index figure plus the margin, then the interest rate will be equal to the lower of (i) the fixed interest rate then being charged by Lender on comparable loan products, or, (ii) the fixed interest rate established under a rate protection agreement, which has not expired, if applicable.
- 5. Change of Permanent Loan Programs. Provided that no default exists under the terms of the loan documents, Borrower may, prior to the Commencement Date and with the consent of Lender, elect to entend the interest rate provisions of the Note that are applicable as of the Commencement Date. Lender may offer Borrower a selection from any one or all of the interest rate programs then being offered by Lender on comparable loan products, provided that borrower (i) qualifies at that time for the loan type selected based on Lender's then current under virting criteria, (ii) provides lender any current financial information requested, and (iii) provided that

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Lender's lien position is not impaired. Depending on the Borrower's circumstances, the program may change from a fixed interest rate to an adjustable rate, an adjustable interest rate to a fixed interest rate or from one adjustable interest rate program to a different adjustable interest rate program. Any rate protection agreement in effect will no longer be applicable in the event the Borrower elects to change loan programs. If Borrower elects to amend the interest rate provisions of the Note, Borrower agrees to execute any and all modification agreements, replacement notes, or other documents that Lender may reasonably require to effectuate the requested change and pay any and all additional clusters.

In orde to exertise the option to select another interest rate program, Borrower must notify Lender in writing of Borrower's selection at least five days before the Commencement Date, but in no event earlier than sixty days before the Commencement Date.

6. Modification Agreement. Following the Actual Completion Date, as defined in the Construction Loan Agreement, in order to convert the to an to its permanent phase, the Lender will prepare a Modification Agreement reflecting the correct Commencement Date, loan, product, maturity date, permanent interest rate and other terms of the permanent loan. The Modification Agreement shall be executed by the Borrower in accordance with instructions provided by the Lender and received to the Lender within twenty calendar days of the date it is mailed to the Forrower by the Lender. Failure to time y return the Modification Agreement will result in the Modification Agreement being invalid and shall constitute a derivate under the Note and the Security Instrument and Lender shall be entitled to exercise any and all remedies set forth in the Note and the Security Instrument. In the event the Borrow er fails to timely return the Modification Agreement. Lender, in its sole discretion, may elect to prepare a new Modification Agreement and modify the interest rate to the higher of the interest rate reflected in the Modification Agreement or the interest rate then being charged by Lender on comparable loan products. Interest shall continue to accrue and be payable at the then construction interest rate until receipt by Lender of the executed Modification Agreement.
